TNPSC BITS

- The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment has launched India's First Pan-India helpline for Senior Citizens, called "Elder Line".
 - \circ $\;$ The Toll-Free Number for this line is 14567.
- Sojat Mehndi (Henna) from Rajasthan, has been awarded the geographical indication (GI) tag.
 - Sojat Mehendi, originating from Mehendi leaves grown in Sojat, is naturally cultivated using the rainwater.
- The Tamil Nadu police museum is set up in the old commissioner's office, Egmore, Chennai.
 - The building was the headquarters of the first Police Commissioner of Madras, Lieutenant-Colonel John Carne Boulderson in 1856.
- The NASA probe (InSight) has detected an earthquake on Mars measuring a magnitude 4.2 that shook the ground for nearly an hour and a half.
 - This is the biggest and longest-lasting quake on Mars.

TN MSME gets Boeing contract

- For the first time, a Tamil Nadu-based Micro Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) has clinched a deal with the largest aerospace firm Boeing.
- ✤ Aerospace Engineers Private Limited, located in Salem, won a long-term contract from Boeing.





Now it will manufacture and supply critical aviation components and parts for the global aerospace company's products.

NATIONAL

Press Trust of India - Election

- Aveek Sarkar, the Editor Emeritus and Vice Chairman of the Ananda Bazar Group of Publications, was re-elected Chairman of Press Trust of India (PTI),
- ✤ It is the country's largest premier news agency.
- ✤ K N Shanth Kumar was elected as the Vice-Chairman.
- He is the Director of The Printers (Mysore) Pvt. Ltd. which brings out Deccan Herald and Kannada language daily Prajavani.



Parshuram Kund

- The government of India has started work for the development of 'Parshuram Kund'.
- It is a Hindu pilgrimage site on the Brahmaputra plateau in the lower reaches of the Lohit river in Arunachal Pradesh.
- The project was sanctioned under the Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) Scheme of the Ministry of Tourism.







Chairman of the Cauvery Water Management Authority



- The Centre has appointed Saumitra Kumar Haldar as the full-time chairman of the Cauvery Water Management Authority (CWMA).
- The government has appointed a full-time chairman, more than three years after the establishment of the CWMA.
- Presently, Haldar is serving as the chairman of the Central Water Commission.

- ✤ The Union Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar launched 'Amul Honey'.
- ◆ Amul Honey is a product of Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation Ltd.





This product was launched under cooperation with the 'National Bee Board (NBB)'.



Ordnance Factory Board dissolved

- ✤ The Defence Ministry has issued an order to dissolve the Ordnance Factory Board (OFB) in effect from October 1, 2021.
- ✤ This order will abolish OFB, an establishment which was accepted by the British in 1775.
- ✤ After October 1, its assets, employees and management will be transferred to seven newly constituted Defence Public Sector Undertakings (DPSUs).







INTERNATIONAL

Japan's Prime minister

- ✤ Japan's former Foreign Minister, Fumio Kishida has won the ruling party's leadership election, virtually ensuring that he will become the country's next prime minister.
- ✤ Kishida won 257 votes in a runoff to defeat Taro Kono.
- Fumio Kishida replaces outgoing party leader Prime Minister Yoshihide Suga.



UNESCO World Book Capital for 2023



- The Director-General of UNESCO, Audrey Azoulay, has named Accra (Ghana) as UNESCO World Book Capital for 2023.
- After Guadalajara (Mexico) in 2022, the city of Accra was selected for its strong focus on young people and their potential to contribute to the culture and wealth of Ghana.
- The Cities designated as UNESCO World Book Capital undertake to promote books and reading for all ages and population groups.





Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission



- The Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission on September 27, 2021.
- This mission was launched under the pilot project National Digital Health Mission.
- The flagship digital initiative involves,
 - \circ $\,$ Creation of a unique health ID for every citizen, and
 - Creation of a digital healthcare professionals and facilities registry.
- The nationwide rollout of the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission coincides with the third anniversary of Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY).

ECONOMY

Ways and Means Advances

- The Reserve bank of India has set the limit for Ways and Means Advances (WMA) for the second half of the financial year 2021-22 i.e. October 2021 to March 2022.
- ✤ It is Rs. 50,000 crores.
- ✤ The Reserve Bank may trigger fresh floatation of market loans when the Government of India utilises 75 per cent of the WMA limit.
- The Reserve Bank retains the flexibility to revise the limit at any time, in consultation with the Government of India, taking into consideration the prevailing circumstances.







PERSONALITIES, AWARDS, AND EVENTS

2021 IHA Blue Planet Prize for excellence

- The 2021 IHA Blue Planet Prize for excellence in sustainable hydropower development has been awarded to the 510-MW Teesta-V hydropower project in India.
- ✤ The project is operated by NHPC Limited.
- The prize was awarded by the International Hydropower Association (IHA) at the biennial World Hydropower Congress.
- ✤ The Teesta-V project is located on the Teesta River in Sikkim.



Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Prize for science and technology 2021

It was announced during the 80th foundation day of the Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR).





- Every year, CSIR presents this award to scientists below 45 years of age for their contributions in biology, chemistry, mathematics, physics, medicine, engineering and earth, atmosphere, ocean and planetary sciences.
- ✤ The award comprises a cash prize of Rs 5 lakh.



Lieutenant General Gurbirpal Singh

- He has taken charge as the 34th Director-General of the National Cadet Corps (NCC).
- ✤ He succeeds Lt Gen Tarun Kumar Aich.
- ✤ He was commissioned into the PARACHUTE REGIMENT in 1987.



SPORTS

T20 World Cup Anthem

- The International Cricket Council has launched the official anthem of the upcoming T20 World Cup.
- It was launched along with a campaign film featuring 'avatars' of Indian batting maestro Virat Kohli and West Indies skipper Kieron Pollard.





- The song is composed by Bollywood music director Amit Trivedi.
- The tournament will begin on October 17 in Oman and UAE, with the final to be played in Dubai on November 14.



10,000 runs in T20 cricket - Virat Kohli



- Virat Kohli became the first Indian batsman to notch up 10,000 runs in Twenty20 cricket.
- This was achieved during his side Royal Challengers Bangalore's (RCB) game against the Mumbai Indians in Dubai.
- He is also the second man after West Indies' Chris Gayle to reach the landmark in both T20 and one-day international cricket.
