- The Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine 2021 was awarded jointly to David Julius and Ardem Patapoutian.
 - This is "for their discoveries of receptors for temperature and touch."

LifeSigns



 Government Rajaji Hospital, Madurai launched a wireless patient monitoring biosensor, called LifeSigns.





- This will be useful in treating patients with infectious diseases that require isolation.
- The device is like a chip attached to the body.
- ✤ It records vital readings such as temperature, pulse, respiration, oxygen saturation level and ECG rhythm without the help of medical staff.

NATIONAL

Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement

- India and the United Arab Emirates formally launched negotiations for a Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement.
- ♦ Both sides will aim to conclude negotiations by December 2021.
- ✤ They would sign a formal agreement in March 2022.

Serotype-2 dengue



- ✤ The Central government convened a high-level meeting on the emerging challenge of Serotype-2 dengue cases recently.
- The States reporting serotype II dengue cases are Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, MP, UP, Maharashtra, Odisha, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, and Telangana.





Tiger rallies



- The Union Environment Minister Bhupender Yadav started off tiger rallies in 18 tiger range States in India.
- ✤ Tiger Rallies were started across 51 reserves as a part of "Wildlife Week Celebration" and "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav".
- Rallies were virtually kicked off in three tiger reserves namely,
 - o Biligiri Ranganathaswamy Temple (BRT) Tiger Reserve, Karnataka
 - \circ Navegaon Nagzira Tiger Reserve, Maharashtra and
 - o Sanjay Tiger Reserve, Madhya Pradesh.
- ✤ The rallies were kicked off with the theme "India for Tigers A Rally on Wheels".

Chacha Chaudhary



- The iconic Indian comic book cartoon character, Chacha Chaudhary has been declared as the official mascot for the centrally-sponsored Namami Gange Programme.
- Chacha Chaudhary has been chosen to especially connect children with the campaign of river cleanliness.





Comics will initially be launched in Hindi, English and Bengali languages.

Election Commission on party symbols

- The Election Commission of India (ECI) has frozen the 'Bungalow' election symbol of the Lok Jan Shakti Party from Bihar.
- Now neither of the two factions of the party will be able to use it in the coming Assembly by-elections.
- ✤ As per the guidelines,
 - A party/candidate has to provide a list of three symbols from the EC's free symbols list at the time of filing nomination papers.
 - $\circ~$ Among them, one symbol is allotted to the party/candidate on a first-come-first-serve basis.
 - When a recognised political party splits, the Election Commission takes the decision on assigning the symbol.



INTERNATIONAL

Molnupiravir

- Molnupiravir has reduced the chances of hospitalisation by half among COVID-19 patients with mild or moderate symptoms.
- This is according to the pharmaceutical company "Merck and Ridgeback Biotherapeutics"
- ♦ Molnupiravir drug has been named as 'EIDD 2801' by the company.
- ✤ Here 'E' indicates it was developed at Emory University of USA.
- ✤ The antiviral drugs work by inhibiting a process by which the virus replicates.







Least Developed Countries (LDC) Report 2021



- ✤ The report was released by the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD).
- This annual report provides a comprehensive and authoritative source of socioeconomic analysis and data on the world's most impoverished countries.
- ✤ According to the report, The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) per capita for the LDC group is less than 10% of the world average (2019).
- There are 46 countries are designated by the United Nations as LDCs.
- The list of LDCs is reviewed every 3 years.





ENVIRONMENT

August 2021 - warmest month

- ✤ August 2021 was the 6th warmest month in 142 years.
- This is as per the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's National Centre for Environmental Information analysis at the USA.
- ✤ The year 2021 was also the 2nd hottest summer on record in Northern Hemisphere.
- ✤ The year 2020 witnessed the hottest summer on record in the Northern Hemisphere.

- The Alibaug white onion of Maharashtra was given the Geographical Indication (GI) tag recently.
- ✤ It has a unique sweet taste, no-tears factor, as well as its medicinal properties.

- The "Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi Award for National Integration and National Contribution 2021" was conferred by Vice President M. Venkaiah Naidu.
- Awards were conferred to "Shillong Chamber Choir", Assam branch of Kasturba Gandhi National Memorial Trust as well as writer Nirod Kumar Baruah.





- This award is one of the biggest civilian awards in Assam.
- ✤ It carries a citation along with a cash prize of Rs 5 lakh.
- Award is conferred in the name of the first chief minister of Assam, Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi.

The World Space Week - October 04 to 10

- The dates commemorate the launch of the first artificial satellite, Sputnik I, on 4 October 1957.
- This is to celebrate science and technology, and their contribution towards the betterment of the human condition.
- World Space Week was declared by the United Nations General Assembly on December 6, 1999.
- ✤ The 2021 theme is "Women in Space!"







World Habitat Day – 04 October



- The United Nations designated the first Monday of October as World Habitat Day.
- ✤ In 2021, World Habitat Day is being celebrated on October 04.
- ✤ The theme for 2021 World Habitat Day is "Accelerating urban action for a carbon-free world".

World Animal Day - 04 October



- The day aims to raise the status of animals and help improve welfare standards across the globe.
- The day was celebrated for the first time in 1925 by the cynologist Heinrich Zimmermann.





World Architecture Day 2021 – 04 October

- The day is celebrated on the first Monday of October in parallel with UN World Habitat Day.
- ✤ This day was created in 1985 by the Union International des Architects.
- ✤ This year's theme is "Clean Environment for a Healthy World".
