





# One Health Consortium



- The Department of Biotechnology has launched a 'One Health' consortium.
- ❖ This is the First 'One Health' project of the DBT.
- ❖ One Health Consortium has been empowered to carry out surveillance of important viral, bacterial, & parasitic infections of zoonotic and transboundary pathogens in India.
- ❖ This project will also look into the use of existing diagnostic tests and the development of additional methodologies to conduct surveillance and understand the spread of emerging diseases.






# **Plastic Waste Recycling Targets**

- ❖ The Union environment ministry has released a draft notification to regulate the extended producer responsibility (EPR) under the "Plastic Waste Management Rules 2016".
- ❖ The draft provides that, quantity of waste will have to be managed by producers, brand owners and importers, who are generate plastic packaging waste across India.

# Coal production



- ❖ The Central Government is boosting its per day coal production from 1.94 million to 2 million tonnes within a week.
- This is to meet the rampant demand for coal by states, power companies, and railways.
- ❖ The Use of local coal up to a 10 per cent blend of imported coal has been granted to permitted power generators to increase coal stocks.

- ❖ Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Industries has topped the Indian corporates in the World's Best Employers 2021 rankings published by Forbes.
- Globally, Reliance is placed at 52nd position among 750 global corporates.

### Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Prerna Sthal

- ❖ Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Prerna Sthal was inaugurated at Naval Science & Technological Laboratory (NSTL), Visakhapatnam.
- ❖ Prerna Sthal was inaugurated to commemorate the 90th birth anniversary of Bharat Ratna Dr APJ Abdul Kalam as well as to commemorate 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'.
- ❖ The NSTL products like Varunastra, Torpedo Advanced Light (TAL) and Maareech decoy are also being displayed on the occasion at NSTL.
- ❖ The NSTL is the premier naval research laboratory working under the Defence Research & Development Organisation.

# Upper limit of legal abortions

- ❖ The central government increased the upper limit of legal abortion to 24 weeks from earlier 20 weeks.
- \* This is for special categories of women.
- ❖ The centre notified the new rules under the Medical Termination of Pregnancy (Amendment) Rules, 2021.





❖ The 24-week upper limit of legal abortions is in line with the advancements in medical technology that allows removal of foetus at a relatively advanced stage of pregnancy.

### Joint Sea 2021 naval exercise

- ❖ China and Russia are holding Joint naval drills called the "Joint Sea 2021 naval exercise" in the Sea of Japan.
- ❖ It highlights the latest sign of growing political and military alignment between Russia and China.
- ❖ The drill started in Russia's Peter the Great Gulf in the Sea of Japan.

#### **EY Index**

- ❖ India has retained the third position in the 58th Renewable Energy Country Attractiveness Index (RECAI).
- The index was released by the consultancy firm Ernst & Young (EY).
- ❖ According to the report, the US, mainland China and India continue to retain the top three rankings.
- ❖ Indonesia is a new entrant to the RECAI.
- ❖ The 2021 RECAI ranks the world's top 40 global markets (nations) on the attractiveness of their renewable energy investment and deployment opportunities.

# **UN BIODIVERSITY CONFERENCE**



- ❖ China pledged to inject \$233 million into a new fund called the "Kunming Biodiversity Fund" recently.
- It is for the protection of biodiversity in developing countries.
- ❖ This decision was taken during a key UN conservation summit, even though major donors disagreed on it.





- ❖ China pledged as it is the world's biggest polluter and seeks to play a prominent role internationally in biodiversity conservation.
- ❖ This summit seeks to establish a new accord, setting targets for 2030 and 2050.

# Ropeway services - Varanasi

- ❖ Varanasi of Uttar Pradesh will become the first city in India to use ropeway services in public transportation.
- ❖ Overall, Varanasi will be the third city in the world after Bolivia and Mexico City to use ropeway in public transportation.
- ❖ The project will be executed on a public-private partnership model.
- ❖ The cost of the project will be divided between the Centre and the state government at 80:20.

### C K Prahlad award

- ❖ Indian American Microsoft CEO, Satya Nadella has won the prestigious C K Prahlad award for Global Business Sustainability Leadership for the year 2021.
- ❖ Apart from Nadella, Microsoft's President and Vice-Chair Brad Smith, Chief financial officer Amy Hood and chief environment officer Lucas Joppa have shared the award for Global Business Sustainability Leadership.
- ❖ The four top Microsoft leaders have received the Award for their collaborative leadership to transform Microsoft into a carbon negative company by 2030 and remove all its historical emissions by 2050.







## Prani Mitra 2021

- ❖ S. Chinny Krishna has been conferred with the prestigious 'Prani Mitra' award for 2021 by the Animal Welfare Board of India.
- ❖ He is the co-founder of Blue Cross of India.
- ❖ This is awarded for his lifetime service to animals.
- ❖ Prani Mitra is the country's highest award for animal welfare.


# Vegan leather initiative
