TNPSC BITS

- The 13th FICCI Global Skills Summit 2022 held in New Delhi.
 - o The theme of the summit is "Education to Employability Making It Happen."
- ❖ The Maharashtra government decided to name the Chipi greenfield airport in Sindhudurg district after the late freedom fighter and socialist, barrister Nath Pai.

NATIONAL

Rollout of 5G

- ❖ 5G networks in India were officially inaugurated at India Mobile Congress 2022.
- ❖ Reliance Jio has also announced that other cities in the country will also get access to 5G services in a phased-out manner by December 2023.
- ❖ Airtel has announced that the telecom operator will rollout 5G services in eight Indian cities.



Swachh Survekshan 2022 awards

- Indore was adjudged India's cleanest city for the sixth time in a row.
- Surat and Navi Mumbai followed it on the next two spots.
- ❖ In the category of best performing states Madhya Pradesh has secured the first position.
- ❖ It is followed by Chhattisgarh and Maharashtra.





- ❖ Among the states having fewer than 100 urban local bodies, Tripura has bagged the top rank.
- ❖ In the category of cities having population fewer than one lakh, Maharashtra's Panchgani was ranked number one.
- ❖ It is followed by Chhattisgarh's Patan (NP) and Maharashtra's Karhad.
- ❖ Haridwar was adjudged the cleanest Ganga town in the category of more than 1 lakh population.
- ❖ It is followed by Varanasi and Rishikesh.
- ❖ Bijnor was ranked the first among Ganga towns with fewer than one lakh population.
- ❖ It is followed by Kannauj and Garhmukhteshwar respectively.
- ❖ Maharashtra's Deolali was adjudged the country's cleanest Cantonment Board.



Registration of IMEI Number

- ❖ The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) has made it mandatory for mobile phone manufacturers to register the IMEI of all handsets made in India with the government.
- ❖ The International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) is the 15-digit numbers that uniquely identify each mobile device.
- ❖ Importers too will have to register with the government the IMEI number of each phone before importing it.
- ❖ The Communications Ministry had earlier rolled out a Central Equipment Identity Register.





❖ The identity register categorises mobile phones based on their IMEI status in three lists – white, grey and black.

Redevelopment of railway stations



- ❖ The Union Cabinet approved the redevelopment of three major railway stations.
- ❖ The 3 stations are New Delhi, Ahmedabad and Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus (CSMT) Mumbai.
- Under this, these stations will be equipped with modern infrastructure and have improved facilities.

Clean India 2.0 Programme



❖ The Department of Youth Affairs of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports launched a month-long nationwide Clean India 2.0.





- ❖ This programme will be launched to collect waste material mainly single-use plastic and create awareness among people.
- ❖ One crore kilogram of waste material including plastic and e-waste will be collected and disposed off with the support and voluntary participation of citizens.

INTERNATIONAL

ICAO Joins International Solar Alliance

- ❖ The International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) signed a MoU with the International Solar Alliance (ISA) during the 42nd session of ICAO Assembly in Montreal, Canada.
- ❖ The event marks a new beginning for solar energy use in the global civil aviation sector
- ❖ It will enable the solarization of the aviation sector across all Member States of ISA
- ❖ It aims to check the growth of CO2 emissions in the Aviation sector, leading to India's Net Zero Targets.



8th World Green Economy Summit

- ❖ It is one of the leading global forums on the green economy.
- ❖ The summit was organised by the Dubai Electricity & Water Authority, Dubai Supreme Council of Energy and World Green Economy Organization in cooperation with WETEX.





❖ The summit was held under the theme 'Climate Action Leadership through Collaboration: The Roadmap to Net-Zero'.



Annexation of Ukraine parts



- * Russia annexed four Ukrainian regions.
- ❖ The 4 Ukrainian territories are Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia and Kherson regions.






❖ Earlier, Russia organized a referendum on Russia's administration of these regions.

PERSONALITIES, AWARDS, AND EVENTS

Command of the International Space Station



- ❖ Samantha Cristoforetti became the first woman from Europe to take over as the new astronaut in command of the International Space Station.
- ❖ The commander is responsible for overseeing the various tasks performed by the station's crew members.
- ❖ She was a former fighter pilot in the Italian Air Force.
- ❖ Samantha is the first non-US woman and fifth woman to become commander since the role was created in 2000.
- ❖ She is also the woman with the longest stay in space after clocking 199 days in orbit in 2014 and 2015.

New Attorney General of India

- ❖ Senior advocate R Venkataramani has been appointed as the new Attorney General of India.
- ❖ He has appointed for a period of three years from the 1st of October.
- ❖ The Attorney General for India is the Indian government's chief legal advisor and is its chief advocate in the courts.





- ❖ They are appointed by the President of India at the advice of the Union Cabinet under Article 76 of the Constitution.
- ❖ He holds office during the pleasure of the President.



Russian citizenship to Edward Snowden

- ❖ The President Vladimir Putin has granted Russian citizenship to former U.S. intelligence contractor Edward Snowden.
- ❖ He exposed the scale of secret surveillance operations by the National Security Agency (NSA).
- ❖ U.S. authorities have for years wanted him returned to the United States to face a criminal trial on espionage charges.

36th National Games

Prime Minister recently inaugurated the 36th National Games in Ahmedabad, Gujarat.





- ❖ Teams from 28 states and 8 union territories are expected to take part in this event.
- ❖ The two new UTs Ladakh and Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu will make their debut at the National Games this year.
- ❖ The last edition of these games was held in Kerala in 2015.
