Basic Geographic Data Of Tamilnadu:

- 1. It comprises 4% of the total area, 6% of the population and 3% of the water resources at all India level.
- 2. It is the 11th largest State in India (with an area of 1.30 lakh Sq.Km)
- 3. It is the 7th most populous State (7, 21, 47,000 according to the 2011 census).
- 4. The State receives an average annual rainfall of **937.5 mm** which is 28% less than the National Average annual rainfall of **1,200 mm**.
