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V. Scholarships And Incentives:

1. Tamil Nadu Rural Students Talent Search Examination (TRUST):

Beneficiary	 For students Whose annual family income is less than Rs.1,00,000/- in rural areas. The students must have secured at least 50 percent of total marks in Class 8 to be eligible for the Scheme
Benefits	The selected students will receive Rs.1000/- per year for 4 years up to Class 12

2. National Means-Cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (Nmmss)

Beneficiary	Selects the students who complete Class 8 with 55% marks for the scholarship
Benefits	The selected students will receive Rs. 12,000/- per annum for 4 years up to Class 12.

3. Student Accident Relief Scheme (SARS)

> Relief to students in case of an unexpected accident at school or during school related activities.
