## NATIONAL

## 1<sup>st</sup> Union minister to die of Covid-19

- Union minister of state for railways and Karnataka BJP MP Suresh Angadi, 65, passed away after he tested positive for Covid-19.
- ✤ Angadi is the first Central minister to die of coronavirus.
- ✤ He was the fourth-term MP from Belagavi.
- ✤ H Vasantha kumar, Congress MP from Kanyakumari is the first MP to die of COVID-19.
- So, Kanniya kumari Lok Sabha Constituency to see First By-Poll in more than 50 Years.
- Previously, in January 1969, the constituency witnessed a significant byelection.
- ✤ It marked the political return of former chief minister K. Kamaraj.

## Essential Commodities (Amendment) Bill - 2020

- The Parliament passed the Essential Commodities (Amendment) Bill, 2020 on September 15.
- ✤ The Bill replaces an Ordinance promulgated in June 2020.
- ✤ It amends the Essential Commodities Act (ECA), 1955.
- The ECA 1955 was used to curb inflation by allowing the Centre to enable control by state governments of trade in a wide variety of commodities.

#### <u>Features of the Bill</u>

Removes commodities like cereals, pulses, oilseeds, edible oils, onion and potatoes from the list of essential commodities.





- ✤ Aims to remove fears of private investors of excessive regulatory interference in their business operations.
- Ensures that interests of consumers are safeguarded by regulating agricultural foodstuff in situations such as war, famine, extraordinary price rise and natural calamity.

## Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Amendment Bill, 2020

- ✤ Foreign Contribution Regulation (Amendment) Bill 2020 was passed by the parliament to amend the FCRA act, 2010 on September 23.
- The bill is aimed at amending the provisions of the FCRA Act to streamline the funding procedure.
- ✤ The bill aims to increase transparency and accountability.
- ✤ It also aims to strengthen the compliance mechanism in the utilisation of foreign contribution.

#### Features of the Bill

- It seeks to prohibit 'public servants' from receiving any foreign funding.
- It proposes to reduce the use of foreign funds to meet administrative costs by NGOs from the existing 50 per cent to 20 per cent.
- It seeks to "prohibit any transfer of foreign contribution to any association/ person".
- It proposes to make Aadhaar cards a mandatory identification document for all office-bearers, directors and other key functionaries of NGOs or associations eligible to receive foreign donations.

### Labour Code reform bills

- Parliament passes following 3 Bills related to Labour Law
  - o Code on Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions,
  - The Industrial Relations Code, and
  - The Social Security Code.
- It aims at amending the laws relating to Trade Unions, conditions of employment in industrial establishment or undertaking, investigation and settlement of industrial disputes.
- With the passage of these three Bills, 29 central labour laws have been codified into four broad codes (the first code on wages was approved by Parliament last year).





It improves ease of doing business and providing universal social security to workers as well.

## **IMPORTANT DAYS**

#### **World Pharmacist Day - September 25**

- This day is celebrated to create awareness about the role of a pharmacist in improving health.
- This day was created by the International Pharmaceutical Federation (FIP) Council at the World Congress of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences in Istanbul, Turkey in 2009.
- ✤ The theme of World Pharmacist Day 2020 is "Transforming global health".



# International day for the total elimination of nuclear weapons- September 26

- The day is observed to enhance public awareness about the threat posed to humanity by nuclear weapons.
- The United Nations General Assembly declared the day in 2013.
- ✤ It is being observed since 2014.
- Every year, the day is marked by the ICAN campaigners all around the world.
- ✤ ICAN is the International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons.





✤ It received the Nobel Prize for peace in 2017.



#### **World Contraception Day - September 26**

- ◆ It is an annual global campaign to improve awareness about contraception.
- This campaign aims to raise awareness about birth control methods available to a woman and her partner to enable them to make an informed decision regarding their reproductive health.
- World Contraception Day was first observed on 26<sup>th</sup> September in 2007 by ten international family planning organizations to raise awareness about contraception.

#### **CSIR foundation Day - September 26**

- The Council of Scientific and Industrial Research was established as an autonomous body in 26, September 1942.
- ✤ CSIR is funded by the Ministry of Science and Technology.
- It operates as an autonomous body through the Societies Registration Act, 1860.
- It has a dynamic network of 38 national laboratories, 39 outreach centres, 3 Innovation Complexes and 5 units.

#### World Environmental Health Day - September 26

- The World Environmental Health Day was launched by the IFEH Council (International Federation of Environmental Health).
- ✤ The observance was inaugurated in 2011 in Indonesia.





Theme of this year is "Environmental health, a key public health intervention in disease pandemic prevention".
