#### TNPSC BITS

- ❖ A Three-day International Snack Festival was organised by Culture Language Indian Connection in Hyderabad.
- ❖ A book titled "India's Lost Frontier The story of Northwest Frontier Province of Pakistan" written by Raghvendra Singh was released.

#### **TAMIL NADU**

#### Brick Tank - Keeladi

- ❖ A brick tank has been discovered by archaeologists from the site of the ongoing fifth phase of excavation at Keeladi in Sivaganga district.
- ❖ The excavation is being conducted by the state archaeological department.
- ❖ The tank measures 3 to 4 feet in length and is about 2.5 feet wide and two feet deep with brick flooring.



- ❖ The structure was like the tank structures discovered by ASI in the first and second phases of excavation at the site in 2015.
- Many of those tanks were interconnected.

#### **NATIONAL**

#### **Electors' Verification Programme**

❖ Electors' Verification Programme (EVP) is an initiative from the Election Commission of India.





- The aim was to make electoral rolls error free.
- The EVP will continue till October 15.
- ❖ The citizens will be allowed to submit verified documents from Digi locker also.



# Angikaar campaign

- ❖ The Union Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry has launched the 'Angikaar campaign'.
- ❖ It is a move aimed at bringing beneficiaries of PMAY (urban) into the fold of other central schemes such as Ujjawala and Ayushman Bharat.
- ❖ The 'Angikaar' aims at reaching out all the beneficiaries of the PMAY(U) in a phased manner.
- ❖ The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs also launched an e-course on 'Vulnerability Atlas of India'.
- ❖ It is a unique course that offers awareness and understanding about natural hazards, helps identify regions with high vulnerability with respect to various hazards.





#### **India-Ghana Foreign Office Consultations**

- ❖ The 1st India-Ghana Foreign Office Consultations was held in New Delhi on 28 August 2019.
- ❖ The President of India visited Ghana in June 2016.
- ❖ The President of Ghana visited India in March 2018 to attend the Founding Conference of International Solar Alliance.
- ❖ The two sides agreed to enhance cooperation in areas of trade and investment, development partnership, defence & security, health & pharmaceutical sector, capacity building & training and people to people contacts.

## Central Board of Direct Taxes - Special Cell

- The Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has notified creation of a five-member special cell to address grievances of start-ups with relation to angel tax and other tax-related issues.
- ❖ The cell will be headed by the member (Income Tax and Computerisation) of the board.
- ❖ The cell will work towards redressal of grievances and mitigate tax-related issues in case of start-up entities with respect to administration of Income-tax Act, 1961.



# $3^{rd}$ Advanced Estimate of Area and Production of Various Horticulture Crops

- ❖ The Department of Agriculture Cooperation and Farmers Welfare of the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare released the 3<sup>rd</sup> Advanced Estimate (2018-19) of Area and Production of various Horticulture Crops.
- ❖ It based on the information received from different States & Union Territories (UTs) and other source agencies.
- ❖ As per the report, the area under Horticulture Crops remained broadly at the same level.



#### **STATES**

#### AB-MGRSBY - Rajasthan

- The Rajasthan government has launched a new health insurance scheme named 'Ayushman Bharat-Mahatma Gandhi Rajasthan Swasthya Bima Yojna (AB-MGRSBY)'.
- It was launched on September 1.
- ❖ The scheme will be implemented after merging the Centre's Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojna (AB-PMJAY) and the state's Bhamashah Swasthya Bima Yojna (BSBY).





#### Bill against 'forced conversion'

- ❖ The Himachal Pradesh Assembly passed a Bill against conversion by force, inducement or through marriages solemnised for the "sole purpose" of adopting a new religion.
- ❖ The Bill repealed the Himachal Pradesh Freedom of Religion Act, 2006.
- ❖ According to the new Bill, if Dalits, women or minors were made to convert, the jail term will be between two-seven years.

- ❖ Namaste Pacific is an event jointly hosted by the high commissioners of New Zealand, Australia, Fiji and Papua New Guinea.
- ❖ The second edition of Namaste Pacific was hosted at the New Zealand High Commissioner's residence.
- ❖ Namaste Pacific is the brainchild of Joanna Kempkers, High Commissioner, New Zealand.
- ❖ Namaste Pacific presented the Pacific culture to India.

# Aqua Aquaria India 2019

- ❖ The Vice President inaugurated Aqua Aquaria India 2019 at Hyderabad.
- It was organised by the Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA).





- ❖ It is a bi-annual event.
- ❖ Theme: Taking blue revolution to India's hinterland.
- ❖ The Vice president also launched the swadeshi 'Pearl' brand Artemia
- ❖ The feed is developed by RGCA (Rajiv Gandhi Centre for Aquaculture) under the Make in India programme.
- ❖ Tiger Prawn cultivation and export was promoted during this event.
- ❖ India's seafood industry is the second-largest aquaculture producer in the world.
- ❖ India is largest exporter of shrimps to the USA, the second-largest exporter of shrimps to Europe, and the third-largest exporter of shrimps to Japan.
- ❖ Aquaculture contributes around 52 per cent of the total marine products export earnings of India.

- \* Rajiv Gandhi Centre for Aquaculture (RGCA) is the R & D arm of The Marine Products Exports Development Authority (MPEDA).
- ❖ Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA) comes under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry.

- Striker Sridarth Nongmeikapam scored a hat-trick.



# **Global Happiness Study**

- ❖ India ranked ninth on happiness index among 28 global markets.
- ❖ The Global Happiness Study surveyed over 1000 individuals in each of the 28 countries.
- Over 77% Indian respondents reported that they were happy.
- ❖ But there has been a 6% drop from 83% in 2018 to 77 per cent in 2019.
- The ranking is as follows
  - 1. Australia and Canada
  - 2. China
  - 3. Great Britain
  - 4. France
  - 5. USA
  - 6. Saudi Arabia
  - 7. Germany
  - 8. India
- \* Russia, Spain and Argentina were placed at the bottom of the list.
