TNPSC BITS

- ❖ Algeria's membership in the BRICS New Development Bank (NDB) has been officially approved and became the institution's ninth member.
- Union Bank of India becomes 1st major bank to become signatory of Partnership for Carbon Accounting Financials (PCAF).
- ❖ The two-day first International Solar Festival was held in New Delhi.
- ❖ Telangana has signed an MoU with the World Trade Centres' Association for the establishment of a World Trade Centre in the proposed AI City near Hyderabad.
- ❖ India's ancient activity, yogasana was included as a demonstration event at the 2026 Asian Games to be held in Aichi-Nagoya, Japan.
- ❖ In a first, India and the United Arab Emirates (UAE) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for civil nuclear cooperation.
- ❖ The site for the new national Queen Elizabeth II Memorial has been announced by the UK government as St James's Park, London.
- ❖ Archer Harvinder Singh and sprinter Preethi Pal was participated as India's flagbearers at the Paris 2024 Paralympics closing ceremony.

- ❖ There is nearly 80 percent shortage of specialist doctors at community health centres (CHCs) across rural India.
- ❖ The country has more than 1 lakh 69 thousand Sub-Centres, approximately 32,000 Primary Health Centres, and 6,359 Community Health Centres.





- ❖ Additionally, there are 1,340 Sub-Divisional and District Hospitals, 714 District Hospitals, and 362 Medical Colleges.
- ❖ Only 4,413 specialist doctors of the requisite 21,964 needed in CHCs in March 2023 were available a shortfall of 17,551 or 79.9 percent.
- ❖ There are 5,491 rural CHCs in 757 districts of the country.
- ❖ The availability of specialists at 868 CHCs in urban areas was slightly better at 56 percent.
- ❖ There are 27,304 doctors and specialists employed across 714 district hospitals in the country, against a sanctioned strength of 33,964.
- ❖ It means that nearly 20 percent of these seats are vacant.
- ❖ India's doctor-population ratio now is 1:836—higher than the WHO prescribed ratio of 1 doctor per 1000 population.

INTERNATIONAL

Taliban's new "Morality Law"



- ❖ Taliban supreme leader has directed officials to enact Afghanistan's "morality law".
- It is formalising and codifying the restrictions on women and other groups in the country.
- ❖ They published the 114-page code, the first formal enactment of such laws since the Taliban took power in August 2021.
- ❖ The code makes it mandatory for a woman to veil her entire body at all times in public, and deems a face covering.
- * Women should not be heard singing or reading aloud even inside their homes.





- ❖ Women and men are forbidden from even looking at each other if they are not related by blood or marriage.
- ❖ Earlier the Taliban banned education for girls beyond Class 6.

Forum on China-Africa Cooperation (FOCAC) 2024



- ❖ China-hosted the Ninth edition of the Forum on China-Africa Cooperation (FOCAC) summit in Beijing.
- ❖ Chinese President Xi Jinping pledged \$51 billion of funding to African countries.
- ❖ The Forum on China-Africa Cooperation was established in 2000.
- * It aims to formalise the strategic partnership between China and African nations.
- ❖ FOCAC Summit is conducted every three years, with the host alternating between China and an African member.
- ❖ The FOCAC counts 53 African nations as its members the entire continent except Eswatini.
- * Eswatini has diplomatic ties with Taiwan against Beijing's "One China" Policy.


Earth's third energy field - Polar Wind

- ❖ Earth's third energy field, ambipolar known as 'Polar Wind', is only existed in theory so far.
- ❖ It has now been discovered by Nasa after a search of 60 years.





- ❖ Polar winds have crucial answers about how Earth's atmosphere evaporates rapidly above the north and south poles.
- ❖ The ambipolar field acts like a conveyor belt which lifts the atmospheric particles into space.
- ❖ Gravitational field is responsible for maintaining our atmosphere and if there were not enough gravity it would go into space.
- ❖ Magnetic field is the shield that protects planet Earth from the solar wind, the stream of charged particles released by the sun.
- ❖ Ambipolar field is counteracts gravity and ejects particles into space.




Mercury's south pole

- ❖ Recently the BepiColombo probe made its 4th flyby near Mercury.
- ❖ The satellite has approached the planet's surface at a record low distance of 165 kilometers.
- ❖ During the visit, the probe has taken the first ever images of Mercury's south pole.
- ❖ The historic photograph was taken when the probe was about 3,500 Km from Mercury's surface.
- ❖ The BepiColombo was Launched in October 2018.
- * This probe consists of 2 spacecraft:






- o Mercury Planetary Orbiter of the European Space Agency and
- o Mercury Magnetospheric Orbiter of the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency.



Europa Clipper Mission



- ❖ Nasa is all set to launch the Europa Clipper mission next month to explore Jupiter's moon Europa
- ❖ The Europa Clipper mission is costing \$5 billion.





❖ It aims to determine whether the ocean believed to exist beneath Europa's icy surface could support life.

ENVIRONMENT

New species of genus Curcuma

- * Researchers have identified a new 'cousin' of the turmeric, *Curcuma ungmensis* in Nagaland.
- ❖ It belongs to the genus Curcuma (the ginger family Zingiberaceae).
- ❖ The family Zingiberaceae has 21 genera and about 200 taxa in India.
- Curcuma is one of the most important and largest genera of this plant family.
- ❖ Curcuma longa, black turmeric (Curcuma caesia) and mango ginger (Curcuma amada) are the well-known being turmeric.
- ❖ In India, the genus *Curcuma* is represented by about 40 species.
- ❖ They found mainly in northeast and southern States and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.


Air Quality and Climate Bulletin 2024

❖ United Nations' World Meteorological Organization (WMO) recently released its 4th annual Air Quality and Climate Bulletin.





- ❖ Europe and China show lower PM2.5 pollution.
- ❖ North America and India see increased emissions from anthropogenic activities.
- ❖ Global Particulate Matter hotspots include agricultural areas in Central Africa, Pakistan, India, China and South-East Asia.
- ❖ PM Reduces crop yields by 15% as it reduces sunlight reaching leaf surfaces.

Asian King Vulture Conservation Center



❖ India's first conservation and breeding centre for the Asian King Vultures was inaugurated in Gorakhpur Forest division.





- ❖ The facility is named as Jatayu Conservation and Breeding Centre.
- ❖ It aims to improve the population of the species, which has been listed as critically endangered in the IUCN red list since 2007.
- ❖ Six vultures (male and female) have been introduced to the facility.
- ❖ According to the action plan, the goal is to release 40 pairs of vultures from the centre over the next 8 to 10 years.

❖ Italy's Jannik Sinner won his second Grand Slam title of 2024 by defeating Taylor Fritz (Germany) in the US Open Men's final.

- ❖ Aryna Sabalenka from Belarus has got past Jessica Pegula (USA) to win her first championship and third Grand Slam title of her career.
