- . American researchers have found a method to be able to trace the origin and the destination of forever chemicals
- These chemicals that are scientifically known as per-and polyfluorealityl substances (PFAS).
- . They are generally useful in applications such as water-proofing, heat resistance, detergents, food packaging and non-stick
- . They are known to stay in the environment virtually forever and contribute to environmental degradation which adversely impacts the health of all organisms including human beings.

- . When non-stick cookware is heated to high temperatures, these chemicals can release toxic fumes into the air, posing health
- . Inhalation of these fumes has been linked to various health issues, including respiratory problems, thyroid disorders, and even certain types of cancer.
- · PFOA belongs to a larger class of chemicals known as per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS).
- · While PFOA is largely phased out, other PFAS compounds may still be present in some non-stick cookware.
- · Non-stick cookware, particularly those coated with polytetrafluoroethylene (PTFE or Teffon), can release toxic fumes when

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

INSAT-3DS Mission







- The INSAT-3DS satellite is a follow-on mission of the third-generation meteorological satellite from geostationary orbit.
- . This satellite is an exclusive mission designed for enhanced meteorological observations, monitoring of land and ocean surfaces for weather forecasting, and disaster warning.
- . The INSAT-3DS satellite will augment meteorological services along with the presently operational INSAT-3D and INSAT-3DR
- This was the 16th mission of the heavy-lift vehicle GSLV-MkII, which has been operational since 2001.

- · His father Nataraja Mudaliar was a weaver whereas his mother Bangaru Ammal was a temple servant. His sister Rajamani Ammal
- · Conjeevaram Natarajan Annadurai was popularly called "Anna" or "Arignar Anna".
- · He was well known for his oratorical skills and was an acclaimed writer in the Tamil language.

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Swadeshi Movement:

. Subramania lyer was a strong supporter of the Swadeshi movement, which aimed at promoting indigenous industries and self-sufficiency.

Home Pule League:

- . In 1916, Subramania Iyer and Annie Bezant founded the Home Rule League, with this he serving as its honorary President.
- . Letter to U.S. President: In 1917, Subramania Iyer wrote a letter to U.S. President Woodrow Wilson outlining the oppression and misrule
- . This letter prompted a detailed discussion in the British Parliament and led to a personal rebuke from Vicercy Chelmsford.
- . Renunciation of Knighthood: In response to the insult from the Viceroy, Subramania lyer renounced his knighthood, declaring it as an impediment to his "legitimate exercise of his civic rights."



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· At the request of Gopal Krishna Gokhale, conveyed to him by C. F. Andrews, Gandhi returned to India on 1915 January 9 which is celebrated every year as a Pravasi Bhartiya Divas.

- . Gandhi gave a tittle to CF Andrews as Deena bandhu ("Friend of the Poor").
- · Gopal Krishna Gokhale was a political guru of Gandhi.
- · Rabindranath Tagore bestowed the title "mahatma" on Gandhi in 1915 while writing his autobiography.
- · Gandhi called Tagore as Gurudev.


- . On 19 April 1917, Gandhi joined farmer's uprising which is took place in Champaran district of Bihar.
- . Tenants from Champaran were forced under the law to plant three out of every twenty parts of their land with indigo plant for their landlords under the so called Tinkathia system.







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- · Later, the Phules started schools for children from the then untouchable castes such as Mahar and Mang.
- . In 1863, he opened a home for pregnant Brahmin widows to give birth in a safe and secure place.
- He opened an orphanage home to avoid infanticide. In this regard, he is believed to be the first Hindu to start an orphanage for the unfortunate children.
- In 1868, Jyotirao decided to construct a common bathing tank outside his house to exhibit his embracing
 attitude towards all human beings and wished to dine with everyone, regardless of their caste.
- In 1873, Phule founded the Salve shodhak Samaj, or the Society of Seekers of Truth, for the rights of depressed classes, to denounce the caste system and to spread rational thinking.
- . His wife Savitribai became the head of the women's section.

District officers under the POSH Act

- Recently, the Supreme Court of India (SC) has directed Ministry of Women and Child Development of all states/UTs to
 appoint district officers under the POSH Act.
- POSH Act stands for Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013.
- . It aims to address the issue of sexual harassment faced by women in the workplace.
- This act mandates States to appoint an officer in every district who would play a "pivotal" role in the implementation of the
- The District Officer would constitute Local Complaints Committees (LCCs) to receive complaints from women employed in small establishments with less than 10 workers.
- . A District Officer's responsibilities also included appointing nodal officers under the Act in rural, tribal and urban areas.

- Tamil Nadu becomes the first state to come out with Tamil Nadu Safe and Ethical Artificial Intelligence (Al), Blockchain and Cybersecurity policies in the country.

- Maharashtra Lokayukta and Upa-Lokayukta Act of 1971, is currently in force in the state.
- Under the existing law, the anti-corruption ombudeman could only recommend action against government officials.

Immigration and Foreigners Bill 2025

Ordered In Ottober was at Manual Day

- . The Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) is Body to bring the Immigration and Foreigners Bill, 2025.
- . The bill repeals all the four existing legislations that deal with immigration and movement of foreigners
- The proposed legislation will replace the existing laws
 - The Passport (Entry into India) Act, 1920
 - The Registration of Foreigners Act, 1939
 - ... The Fereigners Act, 1946; and
 - 11 The Immigration (Carriers' Liability) Act, 2000.
- The proposed legislation also gives the power to the Contre to rectrict or regulate the entry, crit, and movement of fereigners within India.
- * The new Hill imposes a penalty up to Rs 5 laich for unsutherized entry, and up to Rs 10 laich for false pumpert
- The role of universities, bespitals, and other medical institutions admitting the foreign nationals will be specified, along with matters related to passenger and since.





- As per the party decision, DMK contested and won 15 seats in MLA election (Legislative Assembly Election) and 2 seats in Lok Sabha election.
- Anna won in Kanchipuram constituency and went to assembly.



- · According to the petition, the 69% quota was against the fundamental right enshrined in the constitution that no person should be discriminated against in the name of his/her caste, religion, gender, sex. etc.

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- The agitation was also supported by Tamii scholars like Maraimalai Adigal, Somasundara Bharathi, K. Appadurai, Mudiyarasan, A. P. Viswanathamand Ilakkuvanar.

Justice Party - President (1938-1944)

- A political party known as the South Indian Libertarian Federation (commonly referred to as Justice Party) was founded in 1916, principally to oppose the economic and political power of the Brahmin groups.
- The party's goal was to render social justice to the non-Brahmin groups.
- . V. Ramasamy took over the leadership of the party in 1938.

Dravidar kazhagam

- At a rally in salem under the leadership of Periyar at 1944 Aug 27, annadural passed a resolution and declared that the justice party would henceforth be known as the Dravidar Kazhagam.
- It focused its attention on the liberation of women, women's education, willing marriage, widow marriage, orphanagesand mercy homes.



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Theagaraya Chetty is regarded as one of the founders of the non-Brahmin movement in Tamil Nadu and
the first to lead the movement.

Farly Life

- Theagaraya Chetty was born in Egathur, Madras Presidency in Telugu speaking Devanga family on 27
 April 1852
- On graduation in 1873, he entered public life and served as a member of the Corporation of Madras from 1882 to 1922
- He served as a member or Councillor of the Corporation of Madras for 40 years from 1882 till 1922.
- · He also served as the President of the Corporation of Madras from 1920 to 1923.
- He was the first non-official President of the Madras Corporation.
- . He was elected to the Madras Legislative Council in 1910

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- · The two leaders often clashed at Council meetings even though both were non-Brahmins
- Natesa Mudaliar realised that if these two leaders could be brought together it would give the Non-Brahmin movement a fast forward ousb.
- . Thus, Natesa Mudaliar was able to reconcile their differences.

Dravidian Movement

- The Madras Non-Brahmin Association was formed in 1909 by two lawyers from Madras city, P.
 Subramanyam and M. Purushotham Naidu,
- Theagaraya Chetty did not involve himself in the movement until 1912, when the Madras United League was formed
- It was formed by disaffected non-Brahmin members of the bureaucracy like Saravana Pillai, G. Veerasamy Naidu, Doraiswami Naidu and S. Narayanaswamy Naidu with C. Natesa Mudaliar as its Secretary.
- Later in 1912 itself (October), Madras United league was renamed as Madras Dravidian Association.

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Early life

Kilnamandi

Excavation Overview

- Location: Excavations were conducted in July-August 2023 at Kilnamandi, located in Vandavasi taluk, Tiruvannamalai district, Tamil Nadu.
- . Burial Types: The excavations uncovered a sarrophagus placed both in a pit and in a cist.

Iron Objects and Dating

- Iron Objects Pound: A sample collected from a stone circle that entombed a pit burial with serrophagus, along with iron objects, was dated.
- . Mean Calibrated Value: The mean calibrated value for this sample was approximately 1692 BCE.

Significance of the Findings

- Earlier Iron Date: This finding pushed the date of iron usage in Tamil Nadu a century sertier than the date from Mangadu.
- First Sare-ophagus Burial Date: This AMS 14C date (1692 BCE) marked the first time a sare-ophagus burial was dated in Tamil Nadu, adding a new layer of understanding to the region's burial practices.







KS Puttaswamy





- . Justice K S Puttaswamy, the former Karnataka High Court judge and the lead petitioner in the seminal 'right to privacy case',
- · After retirement in 1986, he was appointed as the first Vice-Chairman of the Bengahiru bench of the Central Administrative
- . He had also served as the chairperson of the Andhra Pradesh backward Classes Commission.

Menhir and megalithic burial sites

The Tamil Nadu Department of Archaeology has declared five 'menhir' (single stone) and megalithic burial sites at Kodumanal in Erode district as protected monuments.

Kodumanal is located on the northern banks of the Noyyal and about 42 km from Erode.

Potcherds containing names inscribed in Tamil-Brahmi script were found in a large number, apart from Roman silver coins, procious stones and quarts.

These findings showed that an industrial and trade centre had existed here about 2,300 years ago.

Supreme Court's deadline on President

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•	The Supreme Court has put the President on a three month deadline to decide whether or not to assent to State Bills referre to her by a Governor.
	The count begins from the day the Governor referred the Bill to the President for her consideration.
•	In case of any delay beyond this period the appropriate reasons small have to be recorded and conveyed to the State concerned.
	The States, in turn, must be cooperative to any queries or suggestions from the Centre on the Bills.



- The first provincial conference of Self-Respect Movement was organised by Periyar at Chengalpattu in February 1929. Mr. W.P.A. Soundara Pandian, presided over that conference. In that conference soundrapandiyanar, kutthusi gurusamy, moovalur ramamirtham ammaiyar also participated.
- At Erode, the Second Provincial Conference of the Self Respect Movement was convened by Periyar under the chairmanship of Mr. M.R. Jayakar from Pune, a rationalist leader.


