TAMIL NADU

- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin unveiled the foundation for an integrated Multi-Modal Facility Complex (MMFC) with Kuralagam at Broadway, Chennai.
- ❖ At the India Global Education Summit 2026 in Chennai, the 872-acre Knowledge City is planned in the Tiruvallur district as an integrated academic-industrial ecosystem.
- ❖ The State government has notified the Tamil Nadu Anand Marriage Registration Rules, 2026, Anand Marriages are solemnised according to Sikh marriage ceremonies, commonly known as Anand Karaj.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin announced that the Thiruvottiyur highway in Chennai would henceforth be called 'Vallalar Nedunchalai'.
- ❖ The DMK government plans to install a 125-foot statue of Chola king Raja Raja Chola at the Grand Chola Museum in Thanjavur.
- ❖ In a first of its kind, the Madras High Court is set to use an artificial intelligence (AI)-assisted algorithm system called 'Super law Courts'.
- ❖ The Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology (TNSCST) won the first prize at the 38th Kerala State Science Congress.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister unveiled the statue of the late actor 'Kalaivanar' N.S. Krishnan in Chennai.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister inaugurated the State's first glow garden in Mamallapuram.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin announced that a statue of former Premier (CM) of Madras presidency, Omandur Ramasamy Reddiyar would be installed on the campus of the Government Medical College, Omandurar Government Estate, Chennai.
- ❖ 50 years ago, on February 1, 1976, the Tamil Nadu government was dismissed for the first time in history.
- ❖ The Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman proposed the development of 15 archaeological sites Lothal, Dholavira, Rakhigarhi, Adichanallur, Sarnath, Hastinapur, and Leh Palace across the country into vibrant and experiential cultural destinations.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin inaugurated the renovated Poompuhar tourism complex at Poompuhar, Mayiladuthurai district, Tamil Nadu.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin inaugurated an eco-park at Navalur Lake in SIPCOT (State Industries Promotion Corporation of Tamil Nadu Limited), Siruseri, Chengalpattu district.



- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin announced that the Tamil Biennale will be held in January 2027 at the Tamil Nadu Global Tourism Summit 2026 in Chennai.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu will receive 4.097% of the net proceeds of shareable Central taxes, as per the recommendations of the 16th Finance Commission.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister will inaugurate Ranipet's first car manufacturing, at the State Industries Promotion Corporation of Tamil Nadu (SIPCOT) complex in Panapakkam.
- ❖ The Tamil Nadu government informed the Madras High Court that it issued a Government Order (G.O.) on January 21, 2026, to abolish the police orderly system.
- ❖ Over 500 stone age tools have been discovered in Tiruchi, Pudukottai, and Namakkal districts, Tamil Nadu, suggesting Lower and Middle Palaeolithic habitation.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin unveiled Tamil Nadu's first statue of German philosopher and communist leader Karl Marx at the Egmore Museum complex in Chennai.
- ❖ V.O. Chidambaranar (VOC) Port Authority has become the first port in India to deploy an Anti-Drone System.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu is projected to become a \$150 billion electronics hub by 2030.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu recorded the highest per capita income growth in India, increasing from 0.07% in 2020–2021 to 11.19%.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu recorded its highest-ever monthly deceased organ donations with 33 donors in January 2026.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu's Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) reached ₹31.19 lakh crore in 2024–25, with real growth of 11.2%, the highest among major States.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu ranks first in the country in terms of the number of safe deliveries conducted in Government hospitals.
- ❖ Tamilnadu's Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) has dropped to 35 per lakh live births, and the Infant Mortality Rate (IMR) stands at 12 per thousand live births.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu ranks first in the country with a higher education enrollment rate of 47 per cent, nearly double the national average.
- ❖ The foundation stone for the Rs 261-crore Global Sports City was laid by Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin in Chennai.
- ❖ The Tamil Nadu government signed Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) worth ₹5,980 crore to promote semiconductor and aerospace manufacturing.



- ❖ The 2,300-year-old rock paintings at Kumittipathi village in Coimbatore district remain without protection despite being declared a protected monument in 2025.
- ❖ The Greater Chennai Corporation presented its ₹9,319 crore Budget for 2026–2027.

NATIONAL

- ❖ 77th Republic Day Parade was led by Parade Commander Lieutenant-General Bhavnish Kumar, General Officer Commanding of Delhi Area.
- ❖ The Government of India has notified Coking Coal as a Critical and Strategic Mineral under the MMDR Act, 1957 (Mines and Minerals Development and Regulation Act).
- ❖ The Census will be done in two phases, with the House listing and Housing Census (HLO) to be held from April to September 2026 and the PE in February 2027.
- ❖ India has launched its first AI-enabled university pilot at Chaudhary Charan Singh University (CCSU), Meerut, Uttar Pradesh.
- ❖ Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman proposed to support the mineral-rich states of Odisha, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, and Tamil Nadu.
- ❖ The Supreme Court has ruled that the right to menstrual hygiene is an integral part of the right to life under Article 21 of the Constitution.
- ❖ Tap water coverage in urban areas has increased by 64% since 2011 under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) and AMRUT 2.0.
- ❖ India became the world's second most optimistic consumer market in January 2026.
- ❖ Indian Railways commissioned 472.3 km of Kavach Version 4.0 safety system in a single day, the largest ever in the country.
- ❖ Union Budget 2026–27 announced a new scheme to develop a Buddhist Circuit in the Northeast, The scheme aims to preserve and develop Buddhist temples and monasteries in the northeastern States.
- ❖ The 2026 Delhi Declaration was adopted during the second India–Arab Foreign Ministers' Meeting held in New Delhi.
- ❖ Union Government signed an agreement with various stakeholders to establish the Bharat Container Shipping Line (BCSL) to strengthen maritime logistics.
- ❖ India and China recorded a historic bilateral trade of USD 155.6 billion in 2025, growing by about 12% during the year, Indian exports to China increased by 9.7% in 2025.



- ❖ The Union Government released the first national data on waste-pickers under the NAMASTE (National Action for Mechanised Sanitation Ecosystem) scheme.
- ❖ The Union Ministry for Railways announced the completion of second Mountain Tunnel MT-6 in Palghar, Maharashtra, for the Mumbai–Ahmedabad High-Speed Rail (MAHSR) project.
- ❖ India’s first dedicated Glass Museum is being developed in Firozabad, Uttar Pradesh, known as the “Glass City of India”.
- ❖ Indian Railways has launched India’s first LNG-Diesel dual-fuel DEMU (Diesel Electric Multiple Unit) train at Sabarmati in Ahmedabad.
- ❖ The book Red Lines Redrawn: Operation Sindoor and India’s New Normal, authored by Major General Bipin Bakshi (Retd), Air Marshal Rajesh Kumar (Retd), Ambassador Anil Trigunayat, and Brigadier Akhelesh Bhargava (Retd), details India’s Operation Sindoor.
- ❖ The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) notified the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026, replacing the SWM Rules, 2016, under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- ❖ The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) launched the PAIMANA (Project Assessment, Infrastructure Monitoring and Analytics for Nation-building) portal.
- ❖ The Union Department of Fisheries has sanctioned a Smart and Integrated Fishing Harbour at Mayabunder, Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- ❖ Rajasthan is the largest wool-producing state in India, contributing 16,013.50 thousand kg (47.53% of total production).
- ❖ Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) received the “Great Place to Work” certification for February 2026–February 2027.
- ❖ India participated as a Partner Country at Gulfood 2026 in Dubai for the first time, with participation led by APEDA (Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority).
- ❖ India sent the Devnimori Buddha relics to Sri Lanka for a public exposition in Colombo from February 4–10, 2026.
- ❖ India is in talks with China to explore opening an additional route for the Kailash Mansarovar Yatra, including Shipki La Pass in Himachal Pradesh.
- ❖ India marked 50 years of the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act (BLSA), 1976, which abolished bonded labour.
- ❖ The Sawalkote Hydropower Project is being fast-tracked after the suspension of the Indus Waters Treaty following the 2025 Pahalgam terror attack.
- ❖ Indian Railways has deployed an Artificial Intelligence (AI)-based system to prevent elephant deaths on railway tracks.



- ❖ The SATYA Portal was launched under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY).
- ❖ India has been designated Country of the Year at BIOFACH 2026, the world's largest organic trade fair held in Nuremberg, Germany, from 10–13 February 2026.
- ❖ India has proposed reforms in the Kimberley Process Certification Scheme to improve the regulation of the global diamond trade.
- ❖ A new report by Zscaler has ranked India second globally in enterprise Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning usage.
- ❖ Prime Minister Narendra Modi shifted his official workspace to Seva Teerth, a newly built complex near Raisina Hill in New Delhi.
- ❖ The Indian Army will host the first-ever International Military Adventure Challenge Cup (IMACC – International Military Adventure Challenge Cup) 2026 in the Eastern Himalayas.
- ❖ The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs approved India's first underwater twin-tube road-cum-rail tunnel project in Assam.
- ❖ The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) launched Kaushal Rath, a mobile Artificial Intelligence (AI) awareness initiative under the "Yuva AI for All" National AI Literacy Programme in February 2026.
- ❖ India became the second-largest active smartphone installed base globally in 2025, with over 740 million smartphones in use, after China.
- ❖ Balaghat, Madhya Pradesh, has been selected as the pilot district under the World's Largest Grain Storage Plan in the Cooperative Sector.
- ❖ The Adani Group entered the nuclear power sector after the passage of the Sustainable Harnessing and Advancement of Nuclear Energy for Transforming India (SHANTI) Act, 2025.
- ❖ The Indian Prime Minister inaugurated the first Emergency Landing Facility (ELF) in Northeast India at Moran Bypass in Dibrugarh, Assam.
- ❖ India's first National Cow Culture Museum will be established in Mathura, Uttar Pradesh.
- ❖ The Assam Rifles plans to induct indigenous Tangkhul Hui and Kombai dog breeds into its dog squad and phase out foreign breeds by 2050.
- ❖ The Indian Navy has assumed the command of Combined Task Force-154 (CTF-154) for the first time.
- ❖ The Government of India has launched White Revolution 2.0 to increase milk procurement by 50 % over the next five years.
- ❖ The Union Cabinet has approved the launch of the Urban Challenge Fund (UCF) with ₹1 lakh crore central assistance.



- ❖ Union Home Minister has launched India's first Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC)-based Public Distribution System (PDS) in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- ❖ Tamil Nadu reports the highest incidence of consanguineous marriages among peer States at 28%, according to estimates based on the National Family Health Survey-5 (NFHS-5).
- ❖ Larsen & Toubro (L&T) partnered with NVIDIA to build India's first sovereign gigawatt-scale Artificial Intelligence (AI) factory infrastructure.
- ❖ The Rajya Sabha Member of Parliament P. Wilson introduced a private member's Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2026, to provide reservation in judicial appointments.
- ❖ The Prime Minister presented the M.A.N.A.V. framework at the India AI Impact Summit in New Delhi, M.A.N.A.V. stands for Moral and Ethical Systems, Accountable Governance, National Sovereignty, Accessible and Inclusive Artificial Intelligence (AI), and Valid and Legitimate Systems.
- ❖ 'Bharat GI' is launched by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) to promote India's GI tagged products globally under the tagline "A World Exclusive."
- ❖ India has operationalised its first private-sector helicopter Final Assembly Line (FAL) for the H125 at Vemagal, Karnataka.
- ❖ The Delhi Declaration was formally adopted at the India AI Impact Summit 2026 held in New Delhi.
- ❖ The Ministry of Agriculture has launched Phase-1 of Bharat VISTAAR in Jaipur, Rajasthan, during the AI Summit 2026.
- ❖ The President of India inaugurated the Centenary Celebration of the Ol Chiki script in New Delhi to mark 100 years of its invention.
- ❖ Prime Minister inaugurated the world's first commercial-scale Second-Generation (2G) bioethanol plant that uses bamboo as feedstock at Golaghat in Assam.
- ❖ The 80th anniversary of the 1946 Royal Indian Navy (RIN) Revolt is observed on 18 February 2026.
- ❖ India assumed the chairmanship of the Indian Ocean Naval Symposium (IONS) at the 9th Conclave of Chiefs held in Visakhapatnam.
- ❖ The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has launched India's first Bee Corridors initiative along National Highways.
- ❖ The Indian Navy launched its first indigenously designed and built Cadet Training Ship (CTS) 'Krishna' at the L&T Shipyard in Kattupalli, Chennai.
- ❖ The Prime Minister of India inaugurated India's first Namoo Bharat Rapid Rail Transit System (RRTS – Regional Rapid Transit System) on the Delhi–Meerut corridor connecting Delhi and Meerut in Uttar Pradesh.



- ❖ The union Health minister launched the Secure AI for Health Initiative (SAHI) and Benchmarking Open Data Platform for Health AI (BODH) at the India AI Impact Summit 2026 to strengthen India's health AI ecosystem.
- ❖ The Ministry of Home Affairs has released India's first anti-terror policy, named PRAHAAR.
- ❖ Prime Minister Narendra Modi became the first Indian Prime Minister to address the Knesset Plenum (Parliament of Israel) during his two-day visit to Israel.
- ❖ Amaravati in Andhra Pradesh will host India's first Quantum Valley under the National Quantum Mission.
- ❖ Vice-President C. P. Radhakrishnan has released the updated Tamil and Gujarati editions of the Constitution of India at Uprashtrapati Bhavan.
- ❖ India remained the second-largest buyer of Russian fossil fuels in January 2026, according to data released by the Centre for Research on Energy and Clean Air (CREA).
- ❖ The Indian Navy will commission INS Anjadip at Chennai Port, and it is the third ship under the Anti-Submarine Warfare Shallow Water Craft (ASW-SWC) project.
- ❖ India established its first government-supported National Biobank dedicated to Lysosomal Storage Disorders.
- ❖ The Department of Biotechnology (DBT) has launched "SUJVIKA", an Artificial Intelligence (AI)-based Biotech Product Data Portal, on 25 February 2026, marking its 40th Foundation Day.

INTERNATIONAL

- ❖ The India-European Union free trade agreement (FTA) is widely termed as the "mother of all deals", India allowed European Union (EU) banks to open 15 branches in the country over a four-year period.
- ❖ France's National Assembly backed legislation to ban children under 15 years old from social media.
- ❖ India has agreed to import goods worth about 100 billion US dollars annually from the United States for the next five years.
- ❖ Spain announced a nationwide ban on social media access for children under 16 years.
- ❖ India has joined the BRICS Centre for Industrial Competencies (BCIC) to strengthen manufacturing skills and industrial cooperation among BRICS countries.
- ❖ India backed the FORGE (Forum on Resource, Geostrategic Engagement) initiative at the Critical Minerals Ministerial in Washington DC.



- ❖ A two-year-old, Jude Owens from Manchester (UK), set two Guinness World Records by becoming the youngest player to make a bank shot in pool and a double-pot shot in snooker.
- ❖ China commissioned the world's largest compressed-air energy storage (CAES) power plant in Jiangsu province, with a storage capacity of 2,400 megawatt hours (MWh) and a power generation capacity of 600 megawatts.
- ❖ India has paid \$35.18 million to the United Nations (UN) Regular Budget for 2026, This makes India part of the 'honour roll' of 51 UN Member States who paid their dues in full and on time.
- ❖ US President Donald Trump announced Project Vault, a \$12-billion initiative to build a strategic stockpile of critical minerals.
- ❖ India and the World Bank Group announced the New Country Partnership Framework (NCPF) for 2026–2031 to support India's development aligned with the Viksit Bharat vision.
- ❖ India and the United Kingdom signed a Social Security Agreement in New Delhi.
- ❖ The North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) launched the "Arctic Sentry" mission to strengthen security in the Arctic region after tensions related to Greenland.
- ❖ The World Economic Forum launched the Davos Compact on Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR) in 2025 to support global action against drug-resistant infections.
- ❖ The Union Cabinet approved the Startup India Fund of Funds 2.0 (FoF 2.0) with a corpus of ₹10,000 crore.
- ❖ The Union Government informed Lok Sabha that 8,630 complaints were received against sitting judges in the last 10 years.
- ❖ Cyclone Gezani made landfall in Toamasina, a major port city in Madagascar.
- ❖ A copper tool excavated in Egypt has been re-identified as a possible bow drill after fresh microscopic analysis.
- ❖ India and France launched the India-France Year of Innovation to promote cooperation in technology and research.
- ❖ Archaeologists discovered a 2,000-year-old Iron Age temple complex at Hedegaard in Denmark.
- ❖ The United Nations Environment Programme Finance Initiative (UNEP FI) has launched the UNEP FI Impact Centre, The centre is a specialised platform to support impact management in financial institutions.
- ❖ India and France upgraded their ties to a "Special Global Strategic Partnership" during French President Emmanuel Macron's visit to India.



- ❖ The siege and capture of El-Fasher city in North Darfur, Sudan, has been reported to bear “hallmarks of genocide” following a United Nations-mandated independent fact-finding mission’s investigation.
- ❖ Charax Spasinou was an ancient city in southern Mesopotamia, near the Tigris River in present-day Iraq, recently rediscovered using advanced archaeological technology.
- ❖ Poland withdrew from the Ottawa Convention (Anti-Personnel Mine Ban Treaty).
- ❖ After the India AI Impact Summit 2026, plans were announced for the next global AI summits in Geneva (2027) and the UAE in 2028.
- ❖ South Korea lodged a diplomatic protest against Japan’s Takeshima Day event held on 22 February 2026 in Shimane Prefecture.
- ❖ China is the largest producer of bell pepper (capsicum) in the world.

ECONOMY

- ❖ The Union Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) released details of a new Consumer Price Index (CPI) series, The base year of CPI has been revised from 2011–12 to 2023–24.
- ❖ The National Statistics Office (NSO) will conduct a nationwide Migration Survey from July 2026 to June 2027.
- ❖ Kotak Mahindra Bank became the first bank in India to issue a fully digital Foreign Portfolio Investor (FPI) licence.
- ❖ The United Arab Emirates (UAE) became the largest overseas destination for Indian blue-collar workers in 2025, surpassing Saudi Arabia.
- ❖ India’s gross NPAs (Non-Performing Assets) of scheduled commercial banks fell to a historic low of 2.15% in September 2025.
- ❖ The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) announced a revision of the base year for key economic indicators, Gross Domestic Product (GDP) and Index of Industrial Production (IIP) will have a new base year of 2022-23, while the Consumer Price Index (CPI) base year is revised to 2024.
- ❖ India’s retail inflation was recorded at 2.75% in January 2026 under the new Consumer Price Index (CPI) series (Base: 2024 = 100).
- ❖ The Government of India revised the base year of India’s merchandise trade indices from 2012–13 to 2022–23.



SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

- ❖ The Atomic Scientists set the Doomsday Clock at 85 seconds to midnight on January 27, 2026, the closest it has ever been.
- ❖ The DRDO successfully demonstrated Solid Fuel Ducted Ramjet (SFDR) missile technology.
- ❖ DRDO successfully test-fired the nuclear-capable Agni-3 ballistic missile (surface-to-surface missile) off the Odisha coast.
- ❖ The Indian Air Force's Pechora surface-to-air missile system has been fully digitised to improve air defence capability.
- ❖ The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) released ExoMiner++, an open-source artificial intelligence model to detect exoplanets.
- ❖ Google DeepMind launched AlphaGenome, an artificial intelligence tool that predicts how genetic mutations affect gene regulation and human diseases.
- ❖ A rare red aurora was observed over Hanle, Ladakh, after a powerful solar flare triggered a geomagnetic storm.
- ❖ The James Webb Space Telescope (JWST) discovered the most distant galaxy named MoM-z14.
- ❖ Azista Space achieved India's first in-orbit imaging ("in-orbit snooping") capability by capturing images of the International Space Station (ISS) using an indigenous satellite.
- ❖ ISRO's Space Applications Centre identified a safe landing site near Mons Mouton on the Moon for Chandrayaan-4.
- ❖ Moltbook is an AI-only social networking platform created by Matt Schlicht, CEO of OctaneAI, designed for artificial intelligence (AI) agents to post, comment, and interact without human prompts or moderation.
- ❖ Researchers from India – Australia have developed a flexible and economical biosensor capable of rapidly detecting myoglobin, a critical cardiac biomarker linked to the early stages of a heart attack.
- ❖ iLive Connect was introduced as the world's first doctor-led Artificial Intelligence (AI) powered home healthcare ecosystem.
- ❖ Haven-1 is expected to become the world's first private space station, planned for launch in 2027.
- ❖ Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) and Russia's United Aircraft Corporation (UAC) signed an agreement to produce Superjet-100 (SJ-100) aircraft in India.
- ❖ Recently, the European Space Agency (ESA) has released a high-resolution image of the 2026 Winter Olympic venues in northern Italy using the Copernicus Sentinel-2 mission.



- ❖ Scientists from Stanford University created the first global map of rare continental mantle earthquakes.
- ❖ The AIIMS, New Delhi, conducted the first remote real-time ultrasound on a patient at India's Maitri research station in Antarctica.
- ❖ Bengaluru-based Sarvam AI has unveiled two Artificial Intelligence (AI) language models at the India AI Impact Summit 2026 in New Delhi.
- ❖ VoicERA, an open-source Voice Artificial Intelligence (AI) stack, was launched at the India AI Impact Summit 2026 on the BHASHINI National Language Infrastructure.
- ❖ Gnani.ai has launched Vachana Text-to-Speech (TTS) and Speech-to-Text (STT) models, which are trained on more than one million hours of Indian voice data.
- ❖ BharatGen unveiled PARAM 2 17B, a 17-billion-parameter multilingual Mixture-of-Experts (MoE) foundational model.
- ❖ IIT Madras Global Research Foundation launched its first Applied Artificial Intelligence (AI) Innovation Centre at Dubai CommerCity, UAE.
- ❖ The International Solar Alliance (ISA) launched the Global AI-for-Energy Mission at the India AI Impact Summit 2026 in New Delhi.
- ❖ The Sun produced an X8.3 solar flare on 1 February 2026, the strongest solar flare recorded this year.

ENVIRONMENT

- ❖ Patna Bird Sanctuary in Etah district, Uttar Pradesh and Chhari-Dhand in Kutch district of Gujarat have been added to India's Ramsar network.
- ❖ Sunabeda Wildlife Sanctuary is located in Odisha's Nuapada district, it was recently declared Maoist-free status.
- ❖ The United States is officially out of the Paris Agreement under the administration of President Donald Trump.
- ❖ The Al-Jawf region of Saudi Arabia recorded snowfall in its interior desert areas for the first time in recorded history in late 2025.
- ❖ A pair of peacocks was spotted at about 6,000 ft near Manali in Himachal Pradesh, which is unusual for this species.
- ❖ A faunal survey conducted in Karimpuzha Wildlife Sanctuary, Kerala, recorded several new species in the sanctuary.
- ❖ Volcán de Fuego (Volcano of Fire), one of the most active volcanoes in Central America, erupted recently in Guatemala.
- ❖ The dugong population in Tamil Nadu has been estimated at 270 individuals.



- ❖ The foundation stone for Tamil Nadu's first Sea Turtle Conservation Centre was laid at Guindy in Chennai.
- ❖ Goa became the second Indian state, after Kerala, to publish a state-level Bird Atlas.
- ❖ Researchers discovered a new mushroom species named *Hemileccinum indicum* in the Indian Himalayas.
- ❖ Researchers discovered two new marine worm species along the West Bengal coast in the northern Bay of Bengal, The species are *Namalycastis solenotognatha* and *Nereis dhritiae*.
- ❖ A reticulated python (*Malayopython reticulatus*) was discovered in Sulawesi, Indonesia, It has been recognised by the Guinness World Records as the longest measured snake in the world.
- ❖ *Colyttus bilineatus*, a rare jumping spider belonging to the family Salticidae, was recorded for the first time in India in Assam.
- ❖ Researchers discovered a new orchid species named *Diplozentrum papillosum* in the Idukki district of Kerala, belonging to the *Diplozentrum* genus endemic to the southern Western Ghats.
- ❖ A Rusty-spotted Cat was recorded alive in Shergarh Sanctuary in Baran district of Rajasthan.
- ❖ The 16th Tamiraparani water bird survey recorded over 21,000 water birds in southern Tamil Nadu.
- ❖ A new flowering plant species, "*Dicliptera pakhalica*," has been discovered in Pakhal Wildlife Sanctuary, Telangana.
- ❖ Recently, the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)–Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) achieved captive breeding of the mangrove clam *Geloina erosa*.
- ❖ Researchers have discovered a new dragonfly species named *Lyriothemis keralensis* in Kerala.
- ❖ A recent study reported a rise in lion-tailed macaque populations in human-dominated landscapes of the Anamalai Hills in the Western Ghats.
- ❖ The Sangtam tribal body in Nagaland passed a resolution to protect pangolins and stop illegal hunting and trade.
- ❖ A mud volcano recently erupted in Diglipur in the Andaman Islands.
- ❖ The Indian Grey Hornbill was voted as the 'Bird of Tirupattur' district in a public poll conducted by the Forest Department.
