FIRST IN NEWS

- 1. India's first-ever Solar Roof Cycling Track has been inaugurated in Hyderabad.
- 2. India is launching its 1st national-level framework for climate services, known as the National Framework for Climate Services (NFCS), led by the India Meteorological Department.
- 3. European Union has approved world's first green bond standard to avoid greenwashing.
 - Greenwashing is the process of conveying a false impression or providing misleading information about how a company's products are more environmentally sound.
- 4. **Kasargod** district in **Kerala** has become 1st district in India to declare **official tree, flower, bird and turtle** as district species.
- 5. **Kerala** has become the first state in India **to have gold hallmarking centres** in all districts.
- 6. **Udaipur** is set to become **India's 1st wetland city.**
- 7. India's first dedicated **mass rapid transit system** for regional connectivity called as **Regional Rapid Transit System** (**Namo Bharat Train**) was launched.
- 8. **Jharkhand** is the 1st state which has taken steps towards bringing people working on contract or commission for companies like Swiggy-Zomato-Ola-Uber-Rapido under the **ambit of minimum wages**.

- 2. Asian Development Bank has approved a **\$200 million** loan to strengthen flood and river bank erosion risk management along the main stem of the Brahmaputra River in Assam.
- 3. The **Delhi government** has launched a 'green war room' to combat air pollution in the city by implementing the Winter Action Plan and monitoring pollution 24×7.
- 4. **Operation Kachchhap** was conducted by **Directorate of Revenue** Intelligence (DRI) to thwart the illegal trafficking and trading of Gangetic turtles.
- The International Coral Reef Initiative has launched the Coral Reef Breakthrough. It aims to safeguard at least 125,000 Km² of shallowwater tropical coral reefs by 2030 through investments of at least US\$12 billion.

 - > It is a rare genetic disorder in which involves dysfunctional metabolism of sphingolipids.
- 8. Sampurnanand Optical Telescope completed 50 years of operations which is located in Manora Peak, Nainital.
- 9. Rising Cases of **Thallium** poisoning reported in India particularly in **Maharashtra**. Thallium is also called the **poisoner's poison**.
