FIRST IN NEWS

- 1. First largest indigenous **700MWE Kakrapar Nuclear Power Plant** (KAPP3) in **Gujarat**, starts operating at full capacity.
- 2. Sanchi in Madhya Pradesh becomes the India's first Solar City.
- 3. **Hitachi Payment Services Private Ltd** has launched India's first-ever **UPI- ATM** in association with the **NPCI**.
- 4. India has built the world's first portable disaster hospital, called the Aarogya Maitri Cube. It has been developed indigenously under the Project BHISHM.
- 5. **NPCI** has launched a RuPay **ON-THE-GO (OTG)** ring named as **7 Ring**, the **1st contactless payment wearable ring** which was made in India.
- 6. **Samudra Prahari** is the **1**st **pollution control vessel** for **Indian Coast Guard** in Southeast Asia.
- 7. India's First Lighthouse Festival took place in Goa.

8. The shore temple, **Mammallapuram** is the India's 1st Green Energy Archaeological site.

POLITY

- 1. The Supreme Court has ruled that children born from **void** or **voidable** marriages have the **right to claim a share of their parents' ancestral property** in a Hindu undivided family (HUF) governed by **Mitakshara law**.
- 2. **NCERT** has been granted the **deemed-to-be university status**.
- 3. The Ministry of Women and Child Development is celebrating the 6th Rashtriya Poshan Maah throughout September 2023.
- 4. **National Medical Commission** achieves prestigious **World Federation for Medical Education** (WFME) recognition status for **10 Years**.





5. Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam or the Women's Reservation Bill (128th bill) was recently passed by the Parliament. It aims to reserve one-third of all seats for women in the Lok Sabha and the State Legislatures.

- 8. The old Parliament building, previously known as Parliament House is renamed to **'Samvidhan Sadan**.'
- 9. The Supreme Court of India has decided to revisit the **1998 Constitution Bench judgment in the PV Narasimha Rao case**. It provided the legislators with **immunity from criminal prosecution on bribery charges** for their **speeches or votes** in Parliament.
- 10. Rajya Sabha Chairman reconstituted an **all-women panel of Vice-Chairpersons** in Rajya Sabha.

- 2. European Union Chief **Ursula von der Leyen** warns that **return of wolves** to Europe a **'real danger'** for **livestock** and also for **humans**.
- 3. India proposed to launch a G-20 Satellite Mission for Environment and Climate Observation.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

- 1. **Jais,** the **World's Most Advanced Arabic Large Language Model**, has been released. It is a **bilingual Arabic-English model** that has been trained on a massive dataset of text and code.
- 2. India's 1st solar observatory mission-Aditya-L1, was launched by the ISRO. European Space Agency will support Aditya-L1, providing deep space communication services to the mission.
- 3. ISRO in collaboration with the Space Applications Centre (Ahmedabad), has developed a device named 'Nabhmitra' to enhance the safety of fishermen at sea.
- 4. India and US have launched Renewable Energy Technology Action Platform (RETAP) under the Strategic Clean Energy Partnership.
- 5. **NPCI** has announced the launch of an open-source project named 'Flacon' to simplify the management and use of blockchain.
- 6. After Chandrayaan-3's rover Pragyan, its lander- **Vikram**, has been put into sleep mode.
- 7. **United Kingdom** rejoins European Union's science research programme Horizon Europe.
- 8. **Grene Robotics** in partnership with **BEL** has developed, **India's first indigenous drone defence dome** called **Indrajaal** to counter drone threats.
- 9. **X-ray Imaging and Spectroscopy Mission** (XRISM) and **Smart Lander for Investigating Moon** (SLIM) were successfully launched by **Japan**.
- 10. India has formally requested the acquisition of MQ-9B Reaper or Predator-B drones (UAV) from the United States.
- 11. Indian Council for Medical Research nods to conduct **Truenat test** to **detect Nipah.**
- 12. A first of its kind of **Parlour for Yak Milk** has been established in Nyukmadung village, **Arunachal Pradesh** by Indian council of Agricultural Research –National Research centre on Yak.
- 13. The "safe harbour" provision in the Section 79 of IT Act refers to legal protection for Internet service providers (ISPs) and other intermediaries that host or transmit third-party content online.







- 14. Scientists using the James Webb Space Telescope have discovered methane and carbon dioxide on the exoplanet K2-18b.
- 15. A new cybercrime investigation tool called **TTP** (tactics, techniques, and procedures) has been developed to track cyberattacks that target humans, such as insurance fraud and online matrimonial fraud.
- 16. **Vanadium**, a critical raw material has been found recently in sediment samples collected from the **Gulf of Khambhat in Gujarat**. Its symbol is "V" and **atomic number 23**.
- 17. **Nabhmitra** device is developed by ISRO-Space Applications Centre for the **safety of fishermen**.

- 3. **US Commission for International Religious Freedom (USCIRF)** announced it will hold a hearing on religious freedom in India.
- 4. All reported births, deaths to be digitally registered on the Centre's portal from October 1. This initiative is through the Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Act, 2023, which introduces digital birth certificates.
- 5. The **Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare** has launched an AI chatbot named **Kisan e-Mitra** for the **PM-KISAN scheme**.
- 6. Chief Election Commissioner of India **Rajiv Kumar** signed an MoU with the Electoral Commission Chairperson of Seychelles, **Danny Lucas** to enhance **electoral cooperation**

- 1. China has recently unveiled the "2023 edition of the standard map of China," reaffirming its territorial claims over disputed regions with India.

- 3. Russian President Vladimir Putin refuses to restore the Black Sea Grain deal.
- 4. The **French** government announced that the ban on the **practice of wearing abaya** in state-run schools as it violated the **principle of Laïcité**.
- 5. Supreme Court of Mexico decriminalizes abortion across country.
- 6. Prime Minister Narendra Modi presented a **12-point proposal** to expand cooperation between **India and ASEAN**.
- 7. PM Modi handed over the **ceremonial transfer of G20 Presidency** to **Brazil's** President **Luiz Inacio Lula Da Silva**. **Brazil** will chair the next G20 Meeting.
- 8. **Abraham Accord (2020):** It is a normalization agreement between **Israel** and **several Arab nations**, including the United Arab Emirates (UAE), Bahrain, Sudan, and Morocco, which is facilitated by USA.
