TNPSC BITS

- The Punjab Legislative Assembly unanimously passed a resolution for seeking 30% reservation for women in Parliament and State legislative assembly.
- The 18th meeting of the India-Russia Inter-Governmental Commission on Military Technical Cooperation (IRIGC-MTC) was held in New Delhi.
- The Central Board of Indirect taxes and Customs (CBIC) which works under the Ministry of Finance notified the Korean Won and Turkish Lira in the List of Currencies for Exchange Rate in order to decrease the transaction cost and enhance the ease of doing business.
- The 4th WHO (World Health Organization) Global Forum on Medical Devices "Increasing access to medical devices" concluded at Andhra Pradesh's Medtech Zone in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.
 - It was the first time the WHO Global Forum on Medical devices was held in India.
- The Ministry of Power launched the ECO Niwas Samhita 2018, an Energy Conservation Building Code for Residential Buildings (ECBC-R) on the occasion of the National Energy Conservation Day 2018 (December 14) in New Delhi.
- The Asian Cricket Council (ACC) awarded the hosting rights of the 2020 Asia cup to the Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) in a meeting held in Bangladesh Capital Dhaka.
- T.C. Barupal was appointed the next Ambassador of India to the Republic of Guinea. He is presently the Consul General of India, Zanzibar of Tanzania.
- Tata Steel Limited had been declared as the winner of the Prime Minister's Trophy for the 'Best Performing Integrated Steel Plant' in the country for the performance year 2016-17.
 - It thus makes it the 4th consecutive year for Tata Steel being honoured with this coveted award.

NATIONAL

Panel to select MD for PSU insurance firms

The government has constituted a seven-member panel to select the Managing Directors of public sector insurance companies.





The panel would be headed by Banks Board Bureau (BBB) chairman B P Sharma.

Operation Oliva

- The Indian Coast Guard has recently launched 'Operation Oliva'.
- It has been launched as the part of its annual mission to ensure the safe mid-sea sojourn of breeding Olive Ridley sea turtles in Gahirmatha marine sanctuary area, Devi river mouth, and Rushikulya beach of Odisha.
- The turtle conservation programme is executed in a joint coordination with the forest department of Odisha.

INTERNATIONAL

Nepal bans Indian currency notes above Rs 100

- ✤ The Nepal government has banned the Indian currency above Rs 100.
- The New Indian notes of Rs 2,000, Rs 500 and Rs 200 denominations were banned as the Nepal government has not yet legalised them in the market.
- The move can affect the Indian tourist and Nepali people working in India, who carry the currency in Nepal for transaction.

ECONOMY

'World's largest' free trade deal

- The European Parliament approved a free trade agreement between Japan and the European Union (EU), covering 635 million people and almost one-third of the world's economy.
- The EU-Japan Economic Partnership Agreement will remove duties on almost all agricultural and industrial products as well as open up the service sector and procurement.






ENVIRONMENT

Cyclonic Storm Phethai

- The Cyclonic Storm Phethai is the sixth named cyclone of 2018 North Indian Ocean Cyclone season.
- ✤ The previous five named cyclones are Sagar, Mekunu, Luban, Titli and Gaza.



- Cyclone Pethai has emerged as a deep depression in the Bay of Bengal around 900 kms off Chennai on 15 December 2018.
- ✤ The name was given by Thailand.

STATES

Mizoram Chief Minister - Zoramthanga

- The President of Mizo National Front (MNF), Mr. Zoramthanga sworn in as the Chief Minister of Mizoram for the third time at Raj Bhavan in Aizawl.
- MNF dethroned Congress by winning 26 seats in the 40-member legislative assembly. Congress bagged 5 seats whereas BJP won just 1 seat.
- ✤ Mr Tawnluia sworn in as the Deputy Chief Minister of Mizoram.







Kochi-Muziris Biennale

- The 4th Edition of the India's largest contemporary art exhibition Kochi-Muziris Biennale (KMB) was held recently in Kochi.
- It was held with a theme "Possibilities for a Non-Alienated Life" featuring a dynamic range of multi-media artworks.
- The Biennale was curated by Anita Dube and it was the first Biennale in the world where half of the participating artists are women.

Jharkhand gets "Krishi Karman" award

- The Union Ministry of Agriculture had selected Jharkhand for "Krishi Karman" award in the rice category.
- ◆ The award which carries a cash prize worth Rs 2 crore and a citation.
- ✤ As a gesture of appreciation to the farmers of the state for achieving the milestone,
 - two progressive farmers, i.e. one male and one female, would also be given 'Agriculture Minister's Krishi Karman Award".
- \checkmark Each of the farmers would receive a cash award of Rs 2 lakh along with citation.

Miss Universe 2018 Title

 Catriona Elisa Gray from the Philippines was crowned as the Miss Universe 2018 which was held at in Nonthaburi Province, Thailand.



- She was crowned by Demi Leigh Nel-Peters from South Africa, the Miss Universe 2017 title winner.
- India was represented by Nehal Chudasama in the beauty pageant.
- Tamaryn Green from South Africa and Sthefany Guterrez from Venezuela were the first runner-up and second runner-up at Miss Universe 2018 competition.

Interesting facts

- Spain's Angela Ponce created history as the first transgender woman to participate in the Miss Universe beauty pageant.
- The event was hosted by Emmy Award-winning comedian Steve Harvey.
- The countries of Armenia, Kyrgyzstan and Mongolia participated for the first time in the Miss Universe competition.
- For the first time, the competition was judged by an all-women jury.

National Squash Championship

- The 75th edition of the National Squash championship was held recently in Noida.
- Joshna Chinappa won the National Squash Women's Singles title after she defeated Urwashi Josh.
- It was her 16th National title and with this win, she has equalled the record of Bhuvaneshwari Kumari of winning 16 titles.
- Mahesh Mangaonkar defeated Vikram Malhotra in the final match to win Men's Singles title.
- ✤ This is the maiden title for Mahesh Mangaonkar.

IMPORTANT DAYS

International Day to End Violence Against Sex Workers – 17 December

- The International Day to End Violence Against Sex Workers is observed annually on December 17 by sex workers, their advocates, friends, families and allies.
- ✤ The day calls attention to,
 - Hate crimes committed against sex workers worldwide, as well as
 - \circ The need to remove the social stigma and discrimination

that have contributed to violence against sex workers and indifferences from the communities they are part of.

- First observed in 2003, the International Day to End Violence Against Sex Workers was founded by Dr. Annie Sprinkle and the Sex Workers Outreach Project USA (SWOP-USA), an American sex worker rights organization.
- The International Committee on the Rights of Sex Workers in Europe (ICRSE) adopted the red umbrella as a symbol of resistance to discrimination in 2005.

International Migrants Day – 18 December

The International Migrants Day is observed on 18th December annually to recognize the efforts, contributions, and rights of migrants worldwide.





- ✤ The Theme for the year 2018 is "Migration with Dignity".
- The resolution to observe the day was passed by the UN General Assembly on 4th December 2000.
