# **TNPSC BITS**

- Tamil thatha U.Ve. Saminadha Iyer's 165<sup>th</sup> birthday was celebrated on 19 February 2019.
- Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu presented the Living Handloom Treasure awards, the Poompuhar State Awards and cash awards to three silk farmers.
- Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) has announced that candidates can avail of the 10% quota for the upper-caste poor from 2019 civil services exam.
- UN has appointed Indian official Chandramouli Ramanathan to one of the topmost positions in the Department of Management Strategy, Policy and Compliance (DMSPC).
- Saudi Arabia signed the framework agreement of the International Solar Alliance (ISA) becoming the 73<sup>rd</sup> country to join the India-led renewable energy organisation.

# NATIONAL

### Aero India 2019

- The 12<sup>th</sup> edition of Aero India 2019, the International Aerospace and Defence Exhibition was inaugurated at Yelahanka, Bengaluru.
- ✤ The mega event was organized biennially.
- The Aero India 2019 will be held for 5 days from February 20 to 24 and each day of the 5-day air show would have a special theme.
  - Day one would be Inaugural Day





- The theme for day two is Start-Up Day
- Day three is Technology Day
- Day four would be Women's Day and
- Day five will be Public Day
- During this event Defence Minister Nirmala Sitharaman launched a Coast Guard offshore patrol vessel (OPV) of the Goa Shipyard Limited, a public sector undertaking.

## **INTERNATIONAL**

### **Multinational Cobra Gold Military Exercise**

- Thailand and the US have begun the Cobra Gold annual multinational military exercise at Phitsanulok of northern Thai province in Thailand.
- The exercise will include three components: military field training, humanitarian assistance, and disaster relief training.
- It is one of the Asia-Pacific region's largest multinational military exercises that is held in Thailand every year.
- ♦ It was first held in 1982 and its headquarters is in Bangkok, Thailand.
- This is a Thai-American initiative with an aim to improve coordination between the armed forces.
- India joined this exercise for the first time in 2016 while China was admitted for the first time in 2015 but was only allowed to participate in humanitarian assistance training.

### **Creation of Military Space Force**

- US President signed Space Policy Directive 4 (SPD-4) and ordering the Pentagon to establish the Space Force as the sixth branch of the United States military.
- ◆ It will go along with the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines and Coast Guard.
- But establishing the Space Force will require the Congressional approval.
- ✤ The proposed space force will
  - focus on national security and preserving the satellites and vehicles that are dedicated to international communications and observation.





- Ensure autonomous access to, and freedom to operate in space, and to provide vital capabilities to joint and coalition forces.
- Space could be a new warfighting domain and the US aims to be combat ready with Military Space Force.

# **ECONOMY**

## Capital infusion to 12 public sector banks

- The Finance ministry announced a Rs 48,239 crore capital infusion in 12 public sector banks.
- It would help them to meet regulatory capital requirements and make growth capital available for the stronger lenders.

- The capital was allocated keeping in mind the thresholds set by the Reserve Bank of India in the Prompt Corrective Action (PCA) framework.
- The RBI removed Bank of India, Bank of Maharashtra and Oriental Bank of Commerce from the PCA framework on January 31.





## **SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY**

### **Fateh Submarine**

- Iran recently launched a new locally-made submarine capable of firing cruise missiles.
- This submarine was named the Fateh (Conqueror). It has been equipped with torpedoes and naval mines in addition to cruise missiles.



- ✤ This new submarine is Iran's first in the semi-heavy category.
- It is filling a gap between the light Ghadir class and the heavy Kilo class submarines that the country possesses.
- This launch is one of the most important projects Iran's military have undertaken in the last 40 years mostly because of its vertical launching system.

## **ENVIRONMENT**

### Greenhouse gas emission cut for trucks

- The European Union (EU) agreed to reduce emissions of carbon dioxide (CO2) from new trucks and buses by 30 per cent by a 2030.
- The deal proposes a binding CO2-reduction target for trucks at the EU-level for the first time which includes a clear stimulus for zero and low-emission trucks.
- Trucks account for almost one-quarter of the EU's transport-related emissions and the EU did not have limits on emissions from heavy-duty vehicles till now.






✤ Also, EU agreed in December on targets for cutting emissions from cars and vans.

### **NASA report on Forests**

- ✤ A study by NASA, based on extensive satellite imagery, that India and china were responsible for the largest increase in green vegetation.
- ♦ After the year of 2000, the planet's green leaf area has been increased by 5%, or over two million square miles.



China and India Lead in Greening Due to Human Activity

- China and India account for one-third of the global greening, but contain only 9% of the planet's land area covered in vegetation.
- ♦ China possessing 6.6% of the world's vegetated area. Forests account for 42 percent while croplands make up a further 32%.
- ◆ India has contributed a further 6.8% in green leaf area, with 82% from croplands and 4.4% from forests.

## **IMPORTANT DAYS**

### **International Mother Language Day - February 21**

- International Mother Language Day is every year celebrated on February 21 since the year 2000.
- The annual observance is marked to promote awareness of linguistic and cultural diversity and promote multilingualism.





- It was first recognized in November 1999, when the UNESCO brought the subject in the UN General Conference.
- ✤ Later, the resolution was welcomed by the UN General Assembly in 2002.



- Theme of this year's International Mother Language Day was indigenous languages as a factor in development, peace and reconciliation.
- This year, India and Bangladesh will celebrate the International Mother Language Day together at Benapole in Bangladesh.
- The idea to celebrate International Mother Language Day was the initiative of Bangladesh.
- In Bangladesh, the 21 February is the anniversary of the day when Bangladeshis fought for recognition for the Bangla language.
