TNPSC BITS

- ❖ Founder and Chairman of Jet Airways, Naresh Goyal and his wife stepped down from being board members as part of the plan to save the embattled airlines from going bankrupt.

TAMIL NADU

Ancient port city Poompuhar

- ❖ The Department of Remote Sensing, Bharathidasan University will conduct a research project to trace the history of the ancient port city Poompuhar.
- ❖ This program is funded by Department of Science and Technology (DST).
- ❖ Cauvery Poompattinam or Poompuhar was an ancient port city established by the Chola dynasty at the mouth of the Cauvery during Sangam period.



❖ It had trade links with Asian, Arabian and Mediterranean countries.





- ❖ There are elaborate narrations in the Sangam and post-Sangam literature such as Silapathigaram and Manimekalai about Poompuhar.
- ❖ But around AD 1100, it seems to have become defunct all of a sudden.
- ❖ This research program aims to bring out the socio-cultural evolution of the ancient Tamils in this country and the history of Poompuhar as well.

NATIONAL

New Subjects - CBSE

- ❖ With an aim to boost the analytical ability, physical and mental health of the students, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has decided to introduce 3 new subjects in school curriculum.

Chinook Helicopters

- ❖ The Indian Air Force inducted four heavy-lift CH-47 Chinook choppers.
- The choppers were inducted by Air Chief Marshal BS Dhanoa in Chandigarh.
- ❖ They will be used for various military purposes including deploying of troops and machinery at high-altitude locations along the India-Pakistan border.



❖ Along with military operations, they can also be used for disaster relief, search and recovery operations, medical, evacuation, fire-fighting and civil development.





❖ The Boeing CH-47 Chinook is an American twin-engined helicopter jointly developed by US company Vertol and Boeing Rotorcraft Systems.

INTERNATIONAL

Italy signs Belt and Road Initiative (BRI)

- ❖ Italy endorsed China's ambitious "Belt and Road" infrastructure plan, becoming the first major Western power to back the initiative.
- ❖ Italy is the thirteenth European Union country but the first G7 country to join China's Belt Road Initiative.
- ❖ The agreement is seen as a trade-off wherein Italy needs investment and China has those investment to provide.

Belt and Road Initiative

❖ BRI is a development strategy adopted by the Chinese government involving infrastructure development and investments in 152 countries and international organizations in Europe, Asia, Middle East, Latin America and Africa.



❖ It is also known as the One Belt One Road (OBOR) or the Silk Road Economic Belt and the 21st-century Maritime Silk Road.






Defeat of the ISIS

- ❖ The Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) backed by the US has defeated the International terrorist group ISIS, by capturing the last piece of the territory Baghouz in Syria.
- ❖ ISIS captured and commanded large swathes of land in Iraq and Syria at its peak.
- ❖ ISIS members and sympathisers were responsible for numerous attacks and deaths worldwide.
- ❖ ISIS was founded by Global terrorist Abu bakr-al Baghdadi.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Chandrayaan 2

❖ India's lunar mission Chandrayaan 2, scheduled to launch next month, will carry NASA's laser instruments that allow scientists to make precise measurements of the distance to the Moon.



- ❖ Indian mission carries the NASA-owned laser retroreflector arrays.
- * Retroreflectors are sophisticated mirrors, that reflect laser light signals sent from the Earth.
- ❖ The signals can help pinpoint precisely where the lander is, which scientists can use to precisely calculate the Moon's distance from Earth.

Global Energy Transition index

World Economic Forum has released a report titled the Energy Transition Index (ETI), which compares the energy sectors of 115 countries and analyses their readiness for energy transition.

PERSONALITIES, AWARDS AND EVENTS

Templeton Prize 2019

- ❖ Brazilian physicist and astronomer Marcelo Gleiser has been awarded the 2019 Templeton Prize for his work blending science and spirituality.
- Templeton Prize was established in 1972 by the late Sir John Templeton.





* This honours a living person who has made an exceptional contribution to life's spiritual dimension through insight, discovery, or practical works.

Global Teacher Prize 2019

- ❖ A science teacher from rural Kenya, Peter Tabichi, has won the prestigious 2019 global teacher prize.
- ❖ He is the first teacher in Africa to win the \$1 million award.



- The prize is awarded by the Varkey Foundation under the patronage of Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, UAE Vice President and Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai.
- ❖ This award aims to recognize teachers who have been exceptional in their work and who try to improve the standards of education.

Vice Admiral Karambir Singh

- ❖ The Defence Ministry announced appointment of Vice Admiral Karambir Singh as the next Navy Chief.
- ❖ He is famous for heading Project Seabird the building of new naval base at Karwar.
- ❖ In his earlier appointment as the Eastern Naval Commander, he was responsible for commanding the twin nuclear assets of the Indian Navy.





IMPORTANT DAYS

The Independence Day of Bangladesh - March 26

- ❖ Bangladesh celebrates its Independence Day on March 26.
- ❖ It commemorates Bangladesh's declaration of independence from Pakistan in the late hours of 25 March 1971.
- ❖ Sheikh Mujibur Rahman was the founding father of independent Bangladesh.

World Purple Day - March 26

- ❖ Purple day is celebrated with an aim to increase worldwide awareness of epilepsy, and to dispel common myths and fears of this neurological disorder.
- ❖ Purple day commemoration tries to reduce the social stigmas commonly endured by many individuals afflicted with the condition.



- ❖ The first Purple Day event was held on March 26, 2008.
- ❖ The goal of Purple Day is to increase general public awareness, and to empower individuals living with epilepsy to take action in their communities.
