- ❖ The 2-day summit was organised by the Ministry of MSME (Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises) and Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) in association with Government e-marketplace.

SDG India index 2018

- ❖ The NITI Aayog has recently released the Baseline Report of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) India Index 2018.
- It documents the progress made by India's States and Union Territories (UTs) towards implementation of the 2030 SDG targets.
- ❖ According to the Index,
 - Himachal Pradesh. Kerala. and Tamil Nadu have been ranked on top 3 positions and are on track to achieve the UN SDG.
 - o Assam, Bihar and Uttar Pradesh are at the bottom of the rankings.

- ❖ It was constituted by the EAC-PM (Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister).
- ❖ The committee would be working on challenges in the logistics development and suggest policy reforms for the ease of doing trade in the country.

- ❖ The Ministry of Women and Child Development Ministry released the performance of states & UTs under the maternity benefit programme named Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY).
- ❖ Andhra Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh topped the charts as the best performing states.

New Political capital of Burundi


- ❖ The government of Burundi has declared Gitega as the country's new political capital.
- ❖ Bujumbura, the previous capital of Burundi, will serve as the economic capital of the country.
- ❖ About 85% of the population of Burundi is of Hutu ethnicity, 15% are of Tutsi origin and less than 1% are Twa.
- ❖ Burundi was ranked as the world's least happy nation in the World Happiness Report 2018.





South Korean grain silo - Guinness World Records

- ❖ A dreary grain silo that was transformed into an enormous colourful artwork in South Korea has been named by the Guinness World Records as the largest outdoor mural in the world.
- ❖ The painting depicts a young boy's journey into adulthood covers the outside of giant storage containers in the port city of Incheon takes up 23,688 square meters.
- ❖ The mural was commissioned by the city's government and port authority. It aims at improving the negative view of aged industrial facilities.



ECONOMY

Indian Stock market overtakes Germany

- ❖ India overtakes Germany as the World's 7th largest Stock market for the first time in the last seven years.
- ❖ After the exit of United Kingdom from the European Union, now the European Union has only 'France' in the top seven economies of the world.





GST rate slashed on 23 items

- ❖ The tax rates on 23 goods and services has been reduced by the GST Council which includes movie tickets, TV and monitor screens and others.
- ❖ The new GST rates will be applicable from 1st of January 2019.

MPLETE LIST OF GST RATE CUTS

28% to 18%

- Pulleys, transmission shafts and cranks, gear boxes etc., falling under HS Code 8483
- Monitors and TVs of up to screen size of 32 inches
- Re-treaded or used pneumatic tyres of rubber
- Power banks of lithium-ion batteries, Lithiumion batteries are already at 18%. This will bring parity in GST rate of power bank and lithium-ion battery
- Digital cameras and video

- Vegetables (uncooked or cooked by steaming or boiling), frozen, branded and put in a unit container
- Vegetable provisionally preserved (for example by sulphur dioxide gas, in brine, in sulphur water or in other preservative solutions), but unsuitable in that state for quick consumption

GST on solar power generating plant and other renewable energy plants

GST rate of 5% rate has been prescribed on renewable energy devices & parts for their manufacture (bio gas plant/solar power based devices, solar power generating system (SGPS) etc) [falling under chapter 84, 85 or 94 of the tariff]. Other goods or services used in these plants attract applicable GST

REDUCTION IN GST RATES/EXEMPTIONS ON SERVICES

- GST rate on cinema tickets above ₹100 shall be reduced from 28% to 18% and on cinema tickets up to ₹100 from 18% to 12%
- GST rate on third-party insurance premium of goods carrying vehicles shall be

reduced from 18% to 12%

- Services supplied by banks to Basic Saving Bank Deposit (BSBD) account holders under Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) shall be exempted
- Air travel of pilgrims

by non-scheduled/charter operations, for religious pilgrimage facilitated by the Government of India under bilateral arrangements shall attract the same rate of GST as applicable to similar flights in economy class (i.e. 5%)





SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

First satellite for space-based broadband

- China has launched its first communication satellite to offer broadband internet services to the users worldwide.
- ❖ The communication satellite was launched using a Long March 11 carrier rocket which took off from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Centre in north-western China.
- ❖ The satellite is the first in the Hongyun project planned by the China Aerospace Science and Industry Corp (CASIC).
- ❖ The Hongyun project, started in September 2016, which aims to build a space-based communications network.
- ❖ It seeks to provide broadband internet connectivity to users around the world, especially those in the underserved regions.



SEIS placed on Mars - NASA

- NASA's 'Insight' has placed its first instrument, a seismometer (SEIS) on the Planet Mars.
- ❖ The seismometer, world's first ever instrument placed on another planet's surface, will listen for quakes and wobbles in the Red planet.








ENVIRONMENT

Tamil writer Prapanchan passed away

- ❖ Tamil writer Prapanchan, born S. Vaithilingam, died at a private hospital in the Union Territory after battling cancer.
- Prapanchan's first collection of short stories in Tamil was released in 1961.
- His first short story, 'Enna Ulagamada' was published in 'Barani', a Tamil magazine in 1961.
- He won the Sahitya Akademi Award in 1995 for his novel Vanam Vasappadum (Beyond the Sky).
- He had written 'Vaanam Vasapadum' in the Tamil magazine 'Dinamani Kadhir' in 1993.
- Some of his acclaimed novels include Mahanadhi, Manudam vellum, Sandhya, Kagidha Manidhargal, Kaneeral Kappom, Penmai velga, Padhavi and Erodu Thamizhar uyirodu.

- ❖ It managed to stay at the top with one point more than the current World Champions France.






- ❖ Brazil came at third place followed by Croatia and England.

IMPORTANT DAYS

Winter Solstice & Summer Solstice - December 21

- ❖ The days of the year with the most and fewest daylight hours are called the solstices.
- ❖ Winter Solstice, the shortest day of the year was observed in the Northern hemisphere.
- ❖ Whereas Summer Solstice, the Longest Day of the year was observed in the Southern Hemisphere.
- ❖ The roles are reversed on June 21st when the Northern Hemisphere observes Summer Solstice and Southern Hemisphere observes winter solstice.
- ❖ They are caused due to the tilt of the Earth and its elliptical path around the sun.



National Mathematics Day - 22 December

- ❖ The National Mathematics Day is celebrated on 22nd December every year to commemorate the birth anniversary of famous Indian Mathematician Srinivasa Ramanujan.
