TNPSC BITS

- The Integral coach factory (ICF), Chennai rolls out the country's first ever Selfpropelled Inspection Car (SPIC), which means that it is powered by diesel-electric power pack.
 - Usually a separate locomotive is employed for carrying out inspection works, which is expensive and time-consuming.
- Sadaiv Atal, the Samadhi of Atal Bihari Vajpayee was dedicated to the Nation on the birth Anniversary (December 25) of the former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee.
- The 55th anniversary of Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) was celebrated on December 24th at its 25th Battalion, Ghitorni, in New Delhi.
- The wrestler Bala Rafique Shaikh achieved the Maharashtra Kesari 2018 title by defeating Abhijeet Katke of Pune in the 62nd Maharashtra Kesari Wrestling Championship held at Azad ground, Jalna, Maharashtra.
- The US President Donald Trump announced that deputy secretary of defence Patrick Shanahan will take charge as Acting Secretary of Defence from January 1, 2019.
- The Ministry of Personnel appointed P V Bharathi as the MD and CEO of Corporation Bank, effective from February 1, 2019 till March 31, 2020 – the date of her superannuation.
- The RBI has mandated a three-year cooling-off period for its top retired officials before they can take over as chairman or chief executive of any other entity.
 - To join as a director of any company's board, the one-year cooling period mandate continues.
- The first meeting of the Follow-up Committee for implementation of the Trilateral Chabahar Agreement between India, Afghanistan and Iran was held in the port city of Chabahar in Iran.
- The Indian Navy commissioned its 10th Naval Hospital Ship named INHS Sandhani' at the Naval station Karanja in Uran near Mumbai, Maharashtra.
- The Ministry of Information & Broadcasting organized an India-China Film festival during the first India-China High Level Mechanism on Cultural and People-to-People Exchanges in New Delhi.





- The Indian Railways won 17 awards in the National Energy Conservation awards 2018 held in New Delhi.
 - This was the highest number of awards bagged by a single organisation.

Bogibeel Bridge inaugurated

- The PM of India inaugurated the Bogibeel Bridge on the birth anniversary of the late Atal Bihari Vajpayee i.e. December 25 which is observed as "Good Governance Day".
- This 4.9 km bridge, built by Indian Railways, has become the India's longest and Asia's 2nd longest railroad bridge in Assam.
- Till now Vembanad rail bridge in Kerala was dubbed as the longest railway-bridge in India at 4.62km of length.





- It is the nation's only fully welded bridge and for the first time European codes and welding standards were adhered to and it has a life of about 120 years.
- It is a double-decker bridge having two railway lines on the lower deck and a three-lane road on the upper.
- It connects the southern bank of the Brahmaputra River in Assam's Dibrugarh district with Silapathar in Dhemaji district, bordering Arunachal Pradesh.
- The three road lanes of the bridge can act as three landing strips for the Air Force.



SCINECE AND TECHNOLOGY

SpaceX's first US military satellite launched

- SpaceX launched the U.S. Air Force's newest 'GPS III' satellite on a Falcon 9 rocket from Cape Canaveral Air Force Station in Florida, USA.
- ✤ This GPS 3 satellite replaces an aging GPS 2R spacecraft launched in 1997.
- The solar-powered spacecraft, dubbed "Vespucci," is the company's first official "National Security Space" mission.
- It will provide three-times better accuracy than current systems and will be eighttimes better at anti-jamming.
- Nicknamed Vespucci, it honours Italian cartographer and explorer Amerigo Vespucci, after whom North and South America were named.





- It was competed through the Air Force's Evolved Expendable Launch Vehicle program.
- The successful GPS III SV01 mission marked SpaceX's 21st and final launch of 2018.

- The sixth edition of five-day long Yuva Natya Samaroh was held at Kamani Auditorium in New Delhi.
- It was organised by Sahitya Kala Parishad, Department of Art, Culture and Languages, Government of Delhi.

Drivers' Driver of the Year

- Lewis Hamilton was awarded with Drivers' Driver of the Year after claiming the 5th World Drivers' Championship.
- ✤ After this he became the 3rd man in history to secure the 5th world title.





He was followed by Max Verstappen in the second place, Fernando Alonso in the third place.

First woman to reach 50 World Cup wins - ski races

- American Mikaela Shiffrin became the youngest woman to win 50 World Cup ski races with victory in the slalom in the French Alps.
- She finished 0.29 seconds ahead of Slovakia's Petra Vlhova and 0.37 seconds ahead of Sweden Frida Hansdotter to win in Courchevel victory.

India Squash Championship

- The National champion Mahesh Mangaonkar of Maharashtra and Yash Fadte of Goa clinched the men's and under 19 boys' titles respectively in the CCI Western India Squash Championship.
- The championship was organized by Squash Rackets Federation of India in Mumbai, Maharashtra.

Club World Cup

The European Champion, Real Madrid won 3rd straight FIFA Club World Cup with the win over home team Al-Ain in the final held in Abu Dhabi, UAE.






Real Madrid have now four FIFA club World Cup titles, one title more than Barcelona.
