## TNPSC BITS

- ❖ A 1982 IOFS (Indian Ordnance Factories Service) officer Saurabh Kumar took over as the Director General of Ordnance Factories (DGOF) and chairman of the Ordnance Factory Board (OFB) following the superannuation of P.K. Shrivastava in Kolkata.
- ❖ P K Singh was appointed secretary of the Competition Commission of India (CCI).
- ❖ The Department of Financial Services announced the appointment of Hemant Bhargava, Managing Director, Life Insurance Corporation of India, as the Acting Chairman.
- ❖ A 12-year-old Indian-origin student Dhruv Manoj from Singapore has bagged two gold medals at the World Memory Championships held in Hong Kong.
- ❖ IIT Roorkee professor Jayanta Kumar Ghosh was facilitated with the **National** Geospatial Award for Excellence -2017 (Life Time Achievement Award) by the Indian Society for Remote Sensing.
  - o It has been awarded for his contribution towards the development of geospatial science and applications.
- ❖ The players in France's football team which last year defeated Croatia to win the World Cup were awarded the Legion of Honour, France's highest award for "exceptional service" to the nation, in the New Year's honours list.
  - The football World Cup 2018 at Russia was France's 2nd World Cup title, after the 1998 World Cup.
- ❖ Lakhs of women from across Kerala formed a 620-km long Women's Wall or Vanitha Mathil, that stretched from Kasargod in northern Kerala to the southernmost district of Thiruvananthapuram, to uphold gender equality and renaissance values on January 1, 2019.
- Indian fast bowler Jasprit Bumrah became the highest international wicket-taker of 2018 with 78 wickets.
- ❖ The Eminent English and Odia writer Manoj Das received the Kabi Samrat Upendra Bhanja National Award for Lifetime Achievement in Literature, instituted by the Berhampur University.
- ❖ India defeated Australia at Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) of Australia by the margin of 137 runs and it turned out to be India's 150th Test victory.
  - o It is their first ever Boxing Day Test win in Australia.





## **NATIONAL**

## Doubling Farmers' Income (DFI) committee

❖ The government will soon be appointing a committee to oversee the implementation of the recommendations of the DFI committee.

#### **DFI** committee

- ❖ A committee has been constituted in 2016 to look into the entire agriculture ecosystem in the country to suggest ways and means to reform it.
- ❖ For this purpose, an expert committee headed by Ashok Dalwai was constituted to suggest recommendations.
- ❖ It is expected that farmers' income can be doubled by 2022 by these recommendations.

## Panel to protect Assam's heritage

- ❖ The Union Cabinet has approved the setting up of a high-level committee for implementation of Clause 6 of the Assam Accord.
- ❖ The committee shall examine the effectiveness of actions since 1985 to implement Clause 6.
- It provides for constitutional, legislative and administrative safeguards to protect, preserve and promote the cultural, social, linguistic identity and heritage of Assam.
- ❖ After the Assam agitation of 1979-1985, the accord was signed on 15 August, 1985.

#### INTERNATIONAL

#### France introduced GAFA tax

- ❖ France has introduced a new "GAFA tax" to ensure the global giants pay a fair share of taxes on their massive businesses in Europe.
- ❖ It has been named after the large internet and technology companies Google, Apple, Facebook and Amazon.





## **ECONOMY**

# India's Fiscal Stability Report - RBI

- ❖ The Bi-annual Reserve Bank of India has recently released the 18th issue of the Financial Stability Report (FSR) for the year 2018.
- ❖ The FSR reflects the collective assessment of the Sub-Committee of the Financial Stability and Development Council (FSDC) on risks to financial stability, as also the resilience of the financial system.
- ❖ This is the first such report that has been published after Mr. Shaktikanta Das became the Governor of RBI in December following Urjit Patel's departure.

## **Key Findings**

- ❖ The GNPA ratio of both public and private sector banks showed a half-yearly decline, for the first time since March 2015.
- ❖ The Gross Non-Performing Assets (GNPA) of Scheduled Commercial Banks (SCB) ratio declined from 11.5% in March 2018 to 10.8% in September 2018.
- ❖ The ratio of Restructured Standard Advances (RSAs) steadily declined to 0.5% in September 2018.

#### **STATES**

## 2 initiatives under Krishi Krishak Bandhu

- ❖ The West Bengal government has announced two welfare initiatives for farmers as a part of the 'Krishi Krishak Bandhu' scheme.
  - 1. If a farmer aged between 18 to 60 years dies a natural or unnatural death, the state government will pay his family Rs 2 lakh.
  - 2. Farmers would get Rs 2,500 twice a year for growing a single crop on one acre of land.

#### Maharashtra - 100% electrification

❖ The Maharashtra government has achieved 100% electrification on 27 December, 2018.





❖ The government had set itself a deadline of December 31, 2018 for 100% electrification under the Centre's Saubhagya Yojna, launched in September 2017.

# PERSONALITIES, AWARDS AND EVENTS

## **National Legal Services Authority Executive Chairman**

- ❖ The President has nominated Justice of Supreme Court Arjan Kumar Sikri as the Executive Chairman of the National Legal Services Authority (NALSA).
- ❖ The NALSA was constituted under the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987
- ❖ It has been constituted to provide free legal services to the weaker sections of the society and to organise Lok Adalat's for settlement of disputes.
- ❖ The Chief Justice of India is the Patron-in-Chief and the Senior most Judge of the Supreme Court of India is the Executive Chairman of the Authority.

#### **SPORTS**

#### 34-year-old record broken

- ❖ Indian pace trio of Ishant Sharma, Mohammed Shami and Jasprit Bumrah broke the 34-year record of highest test wickets in a calendar year.
- They have become the most successful pace trio with 131 wickets in 2018.
- ❖ The record was previously held by the West Indies seamers Joel Garner, Michael Holding and Malcolm Marshall who had taken 130 wickets in 1984.

#### Rishabh Pant - Equaling World Record

- \* Rishabh Pant (India) has equalled the world record of most catches in a Test by a wicket keeper with Englishman Jack Russell & AB de Villiers (South Africa).
- \* Rishabh Pant equalled the record by taking 11 catches against Australia in the 3rd Test Match.
- ❖ He also became the 1st ever Indian player to take 20 catches in a Test series by surpassing former Indian cricketers Naren Tamhane and Syed Kirmani.





❖ Brad Haddin from Australia holds the record for taking most catches in a Test series (29).

- ❖ The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) celebrated its establishment day on 1st January, 2019 throughout its laboratories and facilities in the country.
